Before completing the form please ensure that you meet all of the criteria for enrolment as listed below.

The competencies expected of a Level 2 coach clearly reflect the ability to plan, prepare, conduct, review and adapt training and match programs in the context of a yearly plan.

## Course Pre-requisites

- Must have coached at Youth (Year 8-12) or Senior (18+) level in season 2017
- Have a current AFL accreditation at either Youth or Senior level.
- Necessary to have been coaching for a minimum of 2 years
- Need to have previously abided by the Coaches Code of Conduct

## Level 2 Course Outline

The level 2 course is a combination of practical and education sessions with assessment practices also carried out on all participants and will take place throughout a full season.

To complete your accreditation, you must complete the following;

- Attend the two-day workshop
- Complete all aspects of the assessment (this will be described in full at the two-day workshop).

Places on the course are limited, and enrolments will be determined in conjunction with District and Regional Staff.
