Clubs are reminded of the dress requirements for all matches. Financial fines from \$25 per person will apply from round 4.

PLAYERS

All players must be dressed in the uniform registered by the club including jumper, shorts and socks.

Jumpers – Senior teams must only wear jumpers branded with the Carlton Draught logo. Colts must only wear jumpers branded with the West Coast Eagles logo. Non-compliant jumper branding and advertising attracts a \$250 fine.

Shorts – Players must wear black/coloured shorts for home games and white shorts away. Shorts should have “WAAFL” on the side panel. Refer by-laws Part 1, Schedule 2.

Socks – Players must wear club football socks. Ankle, work and cut-off socks are not permitted.

UMPIRES

All umpires, including goal must be dressed in orange WAAFL shirt. Field umpires must have the Midway Ford logo on the back, wear black shorts orange socks. Umpires must be equipped with whistles or goal flags.

RUNNER

Runners must be dressed in the green WAAFL runner shirt, black shorts and enclosed footwear.

WATER CARRIERS

Water carriers must be dressed in the yellow WAAFL water shirt and wear enclosed footwear.

TRAINERS

Trainers must be dressed in the grey WAAFL trainer shirt and wear enclosed footwear.
