Summary: The following by-law amendments were approved by the Board at its 11 th March 2019 meeting.	Action:

1. Amend A2.13.6, Protective Gear to Prohibited Items to include fingernails, including acrylic and fake nails, must not protrude past the tip of the finger even if the participant is wearing gloves, spectacles with metal frame and/or glass lenses.
2. Amend A2.29.7 Notice of Investigation – delete schedule, now refers to a prescribed form which will be online.
3. Amend Schedule A1 Fines for failing to list correct player points on team sheet. This may occur when a player is hand-written on the team sheet.
4. Add “as a minimum” to C2.1.6, As a minimum, a player reaching 17 years of age during the current season’s calendar year may play in any senior womens competition match.
5. Amend C2.1.4, the womens competition grades to include C-Grade.
6. Amend C2.3.1, womens team composition to include C-Grade.
7. Amend C2.3.2, womens ‘Even up rule’ to include C-Grade.
8. Amend 2.5.2, womens playing times and breaks to include C-Grade.
9. Amend D2.5.2, Integrated football playing times and breaks to 15-minute quarters and longer breaks.
10. Add D2.7.6, Integrated Winning Margin - where a winning teams margin exceeds 60 points (10 goals) the team will only be credited with a maximum of 60-point winning margin.
