Jan Cooper



Based in WA, Jan Cooper is known as the driving force behind football's gender revolution. Jan has driven the inaugural eight-team National Women's AFL competition that was fast tracked to launch in February this year.

Jan was born into the football world being the daughter of our very own John and Beryl Cooper. As a former assistant trainer for Swans in the 1980's when John Todd was in charge, Jan was appointed the WAFC female football manager in 2006. She joined the AFL in 2007 and in the past 10 years she has overseen the female football participation grow from 60,000 to current levels of 400,000 and the national women's AFL competition.

Jan was named 2015 AFL Football Woman of the Year and was inducted into the WA women's Hall of Fame in 2017 for her efforts in changing female football.

Jan will entertain us with her strong Swan Districts links as well as the amazing growth of women's football and the future of the game.

In addition, we hope to recognise both Tallan Ames and Tony Notte for their long-standing achievements.


