In order to continue to grow Club Football participation, the WAFC is always looking to provide further opportunities for the community to engage with our clubs.

The AFL will be opening registrations for the 2019 season on Friday 7th September 2018 to ensure registrations are 'Always Open' and allow clubs to promote our existing players to register for 2019 whilst they are still engaged in the season. This will also assist clubs in promoting participation in our game over the AFL finals period whilst interest is at its peak.

The WAFC encourages Clubs to actively promote eary registration but understands that some Clubs may wish to wait until a later date that suits them and their volunteers.

Activation of Early Registration

By actively promoting early registrations, Clubs can get a head start on 2019 by re-registering their current members. The WAFC encourages Clubs to offer discounted rates or joining fees to capture registrations prior to winding up for the season. Clubs will receive promotional and Footyweb support from the WAFC.

All players who register and pay in the month of September will receive a free football for Christmas.

The WAFC will work with clubs who wish to actively promote early registration to provide promotional material & support.

NOTE: The national transfer window will not open early so players transferring clubs will not be able to register during this time.



Clubs Not Wishing to Promote

For those clubs who do not wish to actively promote early registration, it will be business as usual and they can choose to set up and promote their registrations at a time that suits them.

It is important to note however that as registrations will open across the board, there is a potential for some early registrations to still come through. The WAFC will be active in making contact with these members to inform them that their registration has been received and a club official will be in touch post November 1, as we understand that this could occur during a down period for Club volunteers.

Support

We understand that September – November is a key downtime period for volunteers and therefore the WAFC will provide registration support throughout this period. This includes sending an email to all 2019 registrations offering contact and support for the period until the club registrar returns.
