PLAYER AGREEMENT

agree to adhere to the following Player Code of Ethics (listed below) and the Team Values of Perth Football Club RWF XVIs (as devised and agreed to by the RWF XVIs Squad) from 1st February to 30th November.

Players Code of Ethics

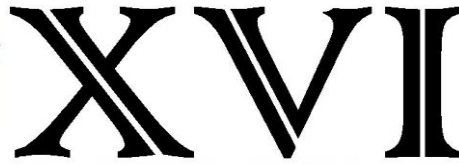
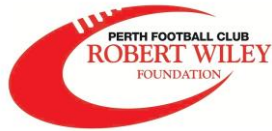
Players must:

1. Abide by all policies of the Perth Football Club (PFC) and the West Australian Football League (WAFL);
2. Neither possess nor use illegal or prohibited drugs or other substances;
3. Not use legal or permissible drugs and other substances in an irresponsible or dangerous manner. i.e.: prior to competition;
4. Abide by the WAFL Drug Testing Protocols;
5. Work towards attainment of their full potential;
6. Work diligently and effectively in their studies and/or occupation;
7. Maintain personal habits of health and behaviour conducive to sporting excellence;
8. Abide by the spirit, as well as the letter, of the rules and codes of the WAFL and AFL competition;
9. Accept victory and defeat with dignity and grace;
10. Ensure that all financial fees of the program are paid within trading terms, unless alternative arrangements have been approved.

PFC RWF XVIs Conditions

Players must:

1. Comply with the medical, gym program, training and playing requirements of the PFC RWF XVIs Program;
2. Advise the PFC Coaches, in advance, of an inability to participate in or late attendance for any training session, trial match or fixtured match.
3. Respond in a positive and proactive manner to the feedback from PFC RWF XVIs Coaches;
4. Follow instructions from PFC Coaching, Physiotherapy, Medical and S&C Staff in regards to football development and injury/illness rehabilitation;
5. Wear the PFC Team Uniform when at training, in competition and at official functions;
6. Behave and dress in a dignified manner when representing the PFC both on and off the fields;
7. Demonstrate positive leadership and role modelling by demonstrating respect for all volunteers and personnel within the football community;
8. Abide by the WAFC Player Code of Conduct;
9. Whilst understanding that I am receiving coaching and instruction from the PFC in a safe environment, I acknowledge that neither the PFC or the WAFL shall be deemed to be responsible or liable (whether in contract or in tort or under any statute whatsoever), for any injury, illness or other mishap I sustain in any way directly or indirectly connected with the PFC RWF XVIs Program;
10. Players are to return, at the end of the current season or when formally requested, all Club uniforms, equipment and resources issued on loan to them.
11. Uphold the Perth Football Club Mission Statement and the Club Values of Respect, Discipline, Professional and Selfless always, both ON and OFF the field.



PLAYER AGREEMENT

WAFC PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

- Understand and adhere to **BYLAW #1 'The Spirit of Junior Football'**.
- Play by the rules.
- Never argue with an official. If you disagree, discuss the matter with your coach after the game.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, or provoking an opponent is not acceptable.
- Work equally hard for yourself and for your team. Your team's performance will benefit so will yours.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good play whether they are by your team or opponents.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
- Cooperate with your coach, team mates, officials and opponents. Without them there would no competition.
- Play for the "fun of it" and not just to please parents and coaches.
- Avoid using derogatory language.
- Be prepared to take responsibility for your actions.

EXECUTED as an agreement.

1. I understand the information provided within the Player Agreement for the period (1st February to 30th November). I accept this offer, the conditions of the Player Code of Ethics and the Team Values of Perth Football Club.
2. I acknowledge and agree that if I breach the Player Code of Ethics, the Club Values of Perth Football Club RWF XVIs and/or knowingly mislead the PFC Staff during the Term of this Agreement, the PFC and/or the WAFL may take action against me in accordance with Disciplinary Action policy;

PFC Disciplinary Action Policy

If a PFC Player is found by the PFC to breach the Players' Agreement, the PFC may, at its discretion:

- a) Issue any specific direction(s) to the player relevant to the conduct that is considered appropriate in the circumstances, including but not limited to:
 - i. Verbal or written apology.
 - ii. Remain under the supervision of the PFC Pathway Development Officer.
 - iii. Provide assistance or compliance with the PFC, the WAFL or AFL affiliates.
- b) Exclude Players from participating activities, such as PFC functions, training, matches or programs, also including WAFL/WAFC activities.
- c) Suspend the Player from the PFC RWF XVIs Program.
- d) Terminate the Player's tenure with the PFC RWF XVIs Program.

The process and decision will be managed and be at the discretion of the PFC Pathway Development Officer or PFC Football Operations Manager.
