# RETURN TO TRAINING & MATCHES PROTOCOLS

AS AT 27TH JUNE 2020

## **10 POINT CHECKLIST FOR FOOTBALL CLUBS RETURNING TO TRAINING AND MATCHES**

This guide has been established to support teams Returning to Training and Matches under the current State Government COVID-19 restrictions.



#### **TRAINING GROUPS**

Clubs / teams can train as per normal. No restrictions are in place on squad sizes on the oval, apart from ensuring 1 person per 2sqm.



#### **CONTACT TRAINING IS ALLOWED**

Clubs can still undertake contact training with participants. Ensure that you progressively add contact training into your sessions for those age groups where contact is permitted.

#### **SOCIAL DISTANCING**

Social Distancing still applies, and we would encourage the 1.5m social distancing protocol to be utilised where appropriate. Clubs must also adhere to the requirement of no more than 1 participant per 2m<sup>2</sup> whilst both inside and outside facilities.



#### **ACCESS TO CHANGEROOMS IS PERMITTED**

Once the club has approval from the Local Government, then changerooms and club rooms can be utilised. Please make sure that the club adheres to the 1 participant per 2m<sup>2</sup> social distancing requirements, and that appropriate venue cleaning is undertaken.



#### **FOOTBALLS AND EQUIPMENT IS ALLOWED**

Footballs and all equipment can be used for all training sessions.



#### CLUBS & TEAMS UNDERSTAND THE RETURN TO TRAINING AND MATCHES PROTOCOLS

The club and all teams have read, understood and agree to adhere to the Guidelines for a Return to Training and matches.



#### **HYGIENE PROTOCOLS ARE IN PLACE**

The club is encouraging all teams and players to still adhere to good hygiene practices, including washing hands and using alcohol based hand sanitisers both before and after training and matches.



#### **A REGISTER OF PARTICIPANTS**

A register or log of participants at training or matches is no longer required under the COVID-19 WA State Government restrictions.



#### **ONLINE EDUCATION RECOMMENDED**

Volunteers are encouraged to undertake the online COVID-19 infection control training. The online training course can be accessed **HERE**.



#### LOCAL GOVERNMENT APPROVAL

The club has received **approval from the Local Government** to access the oval, changerooms and club rooms for training and matches, and understand that they must follow the direction and advice of Police, Local Government and the League at all times.
