John Inverarity West Australian Cricket Legend

**R**obert John Inverarity, born in 1944, played six Tests for Australia between 1968 and 1972. A right handed batsmen and left arm orthodox spin bowler, he was an outstanding Captain for both the Western Australian and South Australian Sheffield Shield teams. He was also Chairman of Selectors for Cricket Australia from 2011 to 2014.

His Shield career spanned twenty three years between 1962 and 1985. He replaced Tony Lock as Captain of WA to win the Sheffield Shield four times in six years, 1971/72 and 1976/77. He played 223 First Class Matches making 11,777 runs and taking 221 wickets.

John was made a Life Member of the WACA in 1985, had a grand stand named after him at the WACA and was awarded the Order of Australia Member medal in 2018. He was named in the West Australian Team of the Century (listed below on the famous WACA scoreboard).

John had a successful career in education. He taught in the UK, Adelaide and was Headmaster of Hale School in Perth from 1989 – 2003.
