Definitions

1. Adding reference to the Perth Football League.
2. Defining "team sheet" as generated from Footyweb.

By-law A2.5 - Type 3 Transfer Permits

3. Amending Dual Registration to allow Type 3 Transfer Permits from AFLNT.

By-law A2.12.7 Team sheets

4. Adding reference to player points required on team sheets where applicable.

By-law A2.14 Coaching

5. Amend coaching course terminology.

Schedules B1, B2, C1, C2, D1, D2

6. Amending playing jumper and shorts, support personnel.

Schedule B3 Player Points

7. Amending the Total Team Points cap to 43 points.
8. Clarifying a combined total of 5 or more matches played to player point categories.
9. Delete Retired, absent, long-term injured uncategorised player (1 point).

By-law C2.1.6 Womens

10. Amending the minimum age for women to play from "17" to "attaining 17 in the year".

By-law 3.5.1. Financial records from aligned - Past Players Associations

11. Amend that each club (including past player's associations aligned to the club) shall submit to the WAAFL its AGM Minutes and audited Financial Reports for the previous year before or with team nominations.

Resulting from Option B implementation.

Category related to Option A implementation.

Recommended by the WAFc to improve player pathway.
