Auskick Coach of the Year:

- Be an accredited Level 1 Auskick Coach.
- Have been a practising coach for a minimum of 2 years at Auskick level.
- Be able to demonstrate a focus on fun and development with the playing group.
- Be able to demonstrate a passion for coaching kids at the beginning of the football pathway.
- Be able to demonstrate the engagement of the parent group in regular Auskick sessions.
- Demonstrate examples of being a positive role model to players and parents.

Modified Coach of the Year:

- Be an accredited level 1 Junior Coach.
- Have been a practising coach for a minimum of 2 years at Junior Level.
- Be able to demonstrate a focus on the development of the playing group.
- Be able to demonstrate that you have the respect of the parent group and the wider WAFC District.
- Have demonstrated leadership amongst other coaches at your club.
- Be able to demonstrate examples of engaging in ongoing coach development.
- Demonstrate examples of being a positive role model to players and parents.

Youth Coach of the Year:

- Be an accredited Level 1 Youth or Level 2 Coach.
- Have been a practising coach for a minimum of 2 years at Youth level.
- Be able to demonstrate that you have the respect of the parent group and the wider WAFC District.
- Have demonstrated leadership amongst other coaches at your club.
- Be able to demonstrate examples of engaging in ongoing coach development.
- Demonstrate examples of being a positive role model to players and parents.
- Be able to provide evidence of a high level of retention in players from the previous season.



Female Coach of the Year:

- Be an accredited Level 1 or Level 2 Coach in the appropriate level for the team you are coaching.
- Have been a practising coach for a minimum of 2 years.
- Be able to demonstrate that you have the respect of the parent group and the wider WAFC District.
- Have demonstrated leadership amongst other coaches at your club.
- Be able to demonstrate examples of engaging in ongoing coach development.
- Demonstrate examples of being a positive role model to players and parents.

Senior Coach of the Year:

- Be an accredited Level 1 Senior or Level 2/ 3 Coach.
- Have been a practising coach for a minimum of 2 years at Senior level.
- Be able to demonstrate that you have the respect of the Club Committee and the wider WAFC District.
- Have demonstrated leadership amongst other coaches at your club.
- Be able to demonstrate examples of engaging in ongoing coach development.
- Demonstrate examples of being a positive role model to players and parents.
