

Umpiring is Everyone's Business

In 2013 over 50% of junior games were umpired by a green shirt umpire in their 1st or 2nd year. The average age of green shirt umpires is 15 – 16 yrs.

Each week in season approxiently 2,500 field umpires are required.

Umpiring is Everyone's Business

Nationally 89% growth in appointments V 13% growth of umpires.

The Annual umpire turnover at community level is 25%

The gap between umpire supply and demand is forecast to exceed <u>20,000</u> by 2014.

Role of The Umpire

• PURPOSE OF THE LAWS

- Laws explain how a match of Australian Football is played and seek to attain the following objectives
- To ensure that the game of Australian Football is played in a fair manner and a spirit of true sportsmanship; and
- To prevent injuries to players participating in a match so far as this objective can be reasonably achieved in circumstances where Australian Football is a body contact sport.
- AFL Law Book 2014 (Spirit of the Law)

FIELD UMPIRE TRAINING

- Tuesday: Individual Game Review (DVD), Team Performance Review, Skill Sessions, Mentoring, Leadership Group, Club Visits, Fitness session.
- Thursday: Law Knowledge, Selection, Preview Game Plan, Fitness session.
- Meetings: Code of Conduct, Core Values, Racial Vilification, Individual Discipline – "Team Integrity" Goal Setting, Benchmarks, WAFL Process, Fitness session.
- A WAFL Umpire MUST hold a minimum Level Two Accreditation
