VENUE & SHOW INFORMATION

BOX OFFICE Ticket purchase and Ticketmaster collections will be available from the Stadium Box Office (Gates 8, 19 & 26), from 3.00pm on the day of the show only. However, to avoid queues on the day patrons are encouraged to print their tickets at home or collect their pre-purchased tickets in advance from a Ticketmaster outlet.

“Hot Tickets” can be collected on Thursday 19th February between 3pm & 7pm from Gate 10, and on show day from 4pm to 7pm from Gate 10.

“Catwalk Packages” will be collectable from the Bill Walker Room on show day. Entry will be from 5pm via gate 5.

ENTRY GATES Please refer to the gate printed on your ticket. Patrons must occupy the seat specified on their concert ticket. No queuing is permitted at the gates prior to 3.30pm. Fans queuing before this time will be moved on by security. All gates will open at 5.30pm.

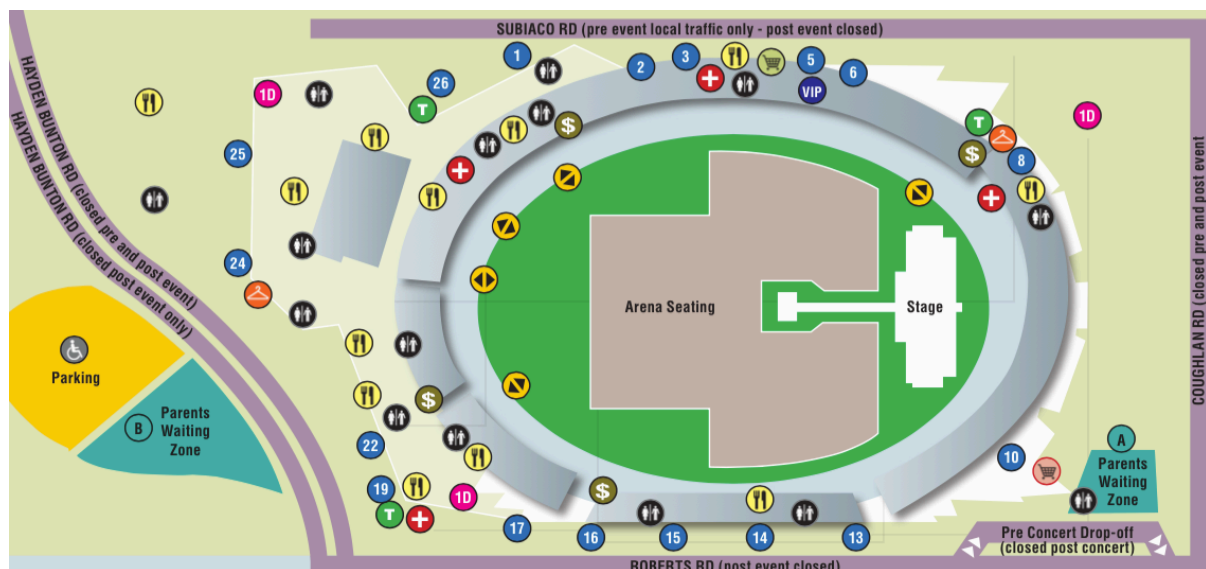
SECURITY & SEARCH ON ENTRY You and/or your possessions may be subject to a safety and security search upon entry. Prohibited items are detailed on the conditions of entry available at www.domainstadium.com.au. Any prohibited items will be confiscated and will not be returned, replaced or reimbursed. Fans with prohibited items may cloak them at designated areas. The movement of patrons on the Stadium site is subject to monitoring by security cameras. Patrons may be filmed/photographed.

CLOAKROOM FACILITIES Cloakroom facilities are located at gates 8 and 24.

PASS-OUTS Pass-outs will not be available at the event, so ensure that you take everything that you require into the concert when you first enter.

FIRST AID is located at gate 3, 7, 19 and 25.

ATM/EFTPOS FACILITIES Limited ATM and EFTPOS facilities will be available within the Stadium. Patrons are advised to come prepared with sufficient cash for the entire evening. Cash-out facilities will be available inside gates 8, 16, 19 and 26.



FOOD & BEVERAGE FACILITIES A range of catering outlets will be available along with bar service. Proof of age photo ID is required to purchase or consume alcohol, and service will not be provided to people less than 18 years of age or intoxicated patrons. The venue reserves the right to deny entry to and/or evict intoxicated patrons or under-age patrons found with alcohol. Domain Stadium is a licenced venue and alcohol cannot be removed from the Stadium.

SMOKING Domain Stadium is a smoke-free venue. Smoking is not permitted.

WEATHER The concert will proceed rain or shine and only exceptionally severe weather conditions will affect the performance. No umbrellas are allowed to be put up whilst in the venue, so bring a raincoat or poncho if inclement weather is predicted. Ponchos will be available for purchase at the venue.

GETTING TO AND FROM THE CONCERT

It is anticipated that there will be heavy traffic surrounding Domain Stadium. You are encouraged to plan your trip, take public transport and arrive early.

BUS & TRAIN SERVICES Your ticket includes public transport before and after the concert. Plan your trip – visit www.transperth.com.au

TAXIS The nearest taxi is on the corner of Hay St and Rokeby Rd Subiaco – approximately 800m away from Gate 19.

ROAD CLOSURES A road closure will be in place on Haydn-Bunton Drive south bound from 4pm. Haydn Bunton will have a full road closure in place in both directions from 9.45pm-10.45pm. Roberts & Subiaco Road will be closed adjacent to the venue from 9.45pm. Please visit the event page at www.Domainstadium.com.au for complete road closure information.

MOBILITY-IMPAIRED ACCESS Wheelchair accessible sections are located on the arena floor, North East Stand, Subiaco Stand and the Three Tier Stand. These sections may be accessed via gate 2 and gate 24.

PARKING FACILITIES Car Parking near the venue is limited and will fill up early, so patrons are encouraged to catch public transport to and from the event.

ACROD ACROD Car Parking will be available at Market Square from 2.30pm on show day.

FANS DROP-OFF AREA Drop off area is located at the side road of Roberts Road – please refer to map. No post event pick up is available in this area due to road closures.

PARENT / GUARDIAN MEETING & WAITING ZONES Parent meeting zones are designated at gate 10 and Market Square – please refer to map. The zone at gate 10 will be set up with additional waiting facilities. Parents & guardians are advised to park and walk in due to road closures.

LOST CHILD POINT In the event a minor or dependant is found missing and is unable to relocate with their guardian, the minor will be transferred to either the gate 8 or 24 Lost Child Point.

ONE DIRECTION GIFTS One Direction fans who intend to bring gifts for the band are encouraged to register them at Gate 8 Customer Service so that they may be delivered to the band after the concert. Fans are reminded that some items are prohibited from entering the stadium and as such your gift must be unwrapped prior to presenting to Gate 8 Customer Service.

AGE RESTRICTION Fans under 13 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian as per the terms of the ticket sale. Juvenile patrons are to be supervised and in the care of their parent or guardian at all times.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The venue's complete Conditions of Entry can be viewed on line, visit domainstadium.com.au Please note that conditions are subject to change without notice and may vary from event to event. The venue and promoter reserve the right to deny entry to, or evict, any person.

PROHIBITED

- Stand alone video cameras (sole purpose device)
- Cameras with lens greater than 75mm
- Stand alone audio recording devices (sole purpose device)
- Cans and other metal containers
- Glass of any kind
- Strictly NO alcohol
- Commercially prepared food or beverages
- Open drink containers
- Metal utensils, cutlery etc
- Illegal substances
- Laser pointing devices, flares, fireworks or any other explosive device
- Long chains or spikes/studs of any nature
- Offensive weapons including but not limited to any object that may be used as a projectile such as glow sticks, balls, containers etc
- Musical instruments including air horns, loud hailer or whistles
- Umbrellas are permitted inside Domain Stadium, however, cannot be opened within Domain Stadium
- Sun/rain shelters
- Chairs or stools
- Skateboards, rollerblades, bicycles or scooters
- Unauthorised temporary signage and promotional products
- Flags/banners/signs over 400mm x 400mm in size (suggested size is A3 paper max)
- Poles, sticks and handles of any kind for signs or similar including Selfie-Sticks
- Any large items that cannot be placed under a seat without impeding access
- Animals (other than Assistance dogs)
- Any other items deemed to be illegal, dangerous or a nuisance to yourself or others

** Please note that prohibited items may be confiscated so if in doubt leave it at home or in your car. Venue and Promoter take no responsibility for confiscated items.

PERMITTED

- Small personal cameras and camera phones are allowed (professional cameras with detachable lenses and/or tripods are not)
- Sun hat and sunscreen
- Jacket/poncho for inclement weather
- Sealed plastic bottles of water (lids will be removed upon entry)
