**S**teven Armstrong has joined Swan Districts this year as an assistant coach with great experience. He is part of a famous sporting family in WA and played a total of 79 AFL Games with Melbourne (2002-2005) and West Coast (2006-2008). Drafted at Pick 25 in 2001, he was a member of the West Coast Premiership side of 2006, kicking the Eagles penultimate goal in the final quarter of that one point victory.

Steven is a third generation coach in the WAFL. His grandfather Ken was a champion centreman for Perth in the 1950's and 60's (170 games) and then went on to Coach Perth to their last Premierships in 1976 and 77 and also coached at Subiaco. His father Gary played and coached Perth in 1999 and 2000.






