
Lest we Forget

He was an active member of the Swansmen Committee for many years, being instrumental in the running of the annual auction and the mafia nights. He was very generous with his donations to the Club and never short of quick wit at our meetings. Dave was awarded the Swan Districts FC Certificate of Merit in 2000 for his service to the Football Club. Dave was a surprise guest at our away meeting at the Woodbridge Hotel last October. We extend our condolences to his wife Judy and family and may he rest in peace.
