



Introducing Eagles Faction Footy

The West Coast Eagles and the WA Football Commission have formed a fantastic new partnership to increase participation in our National Game and enhance the fitness and academic skills of thousands of WA students through active participation in *Eagles Faction Footy*.

Eagles Faction Footy can be conducted as part of the AFL SEPEP and can be successfully incorporated into the two hours of compulsory PE and Sport per week.

How Eagles Faction Footy Works

Eagles Faction Footy is a flexible competition that can be played with variations to suit your school. The following suggested format is a good starting point:

- Involve students in years 4-7 to form a team of 6-10 players (ie 4 faction teams).
- All year levels can play e.g. a school may have more than one competition.
- Teams can play for their Faction and the points could go to the Faction Shield.
- Teams play for a minimum of 6 games over approximately 6 weeks Competitions can be conducted in any term (however most competitions will be in terms 2 and 3).
- Competition rules can be designed by the students or they may use the AFL Recreational Footy rules.
- Games can be played in PE/Sport time, at lunchtime and/or after school.

Requirements for Eagles Faction Footy

- Play a minimum of one competition with a minimum of 4 teams for at least 6 games and/or weeks.
- Competition to be coordinated by the AFL School Ambassador or nominated PE teacher

Resources Provided for Eagles Faction Footy

The West Coast Eagles and the WA Football Commission will provide the following resources to each school:

- 5 Eagles Faction Footy footballs
- · Certificates for all participants
- 1 shield for the winning *Eagles Faction Footy* teams
- Faction Football Bibs

We will endeavour to supply as many sets of bibs and goals posts as we can to schools who register. However with a finite budget and a potential market of 600 schools we cannot supply all the equipment for the program to every school.

* Sets of faction coloured bibs can be purchased for a subsidized cost of \$75 per set (including GST) of 10.

When conducted in conjunction with the *AFL SPORT EDUCATION in a PHYSICAL EDUCATION PROGRAM* (AFL SEPEP), Eagles Faction Footy provides you and your students;

- Extended learning tasks
- · Development of leadership skills
- Students taking more active role in their learning
- Collaborative learning opportunities
- Demonstrating not only knowledge but also essential skills in a variety of contexts that extend beyond the classroom and school
- Balance of teacher directed and student centred teaching/learning strategies.
