

A true gentleman in every respect.
George played very little football but
.through active involvement in his local
community became interested in the
Floreat Park Amateur Football Club
and joined it in 1962 as an official.
From that start began an uninterrupted
period of 36 years of distinctive service
to Amateur Football.

His record reads thus, A Club Delegate and member of the
WAAFL Management Committee since 1
963. President of Floreat Park AFC
1965-67, 1971-72 and was awarded
Life Membership of that Club in 1972.
George was Timekeeper of State
Amateur Teams and at Carnivals from
1976 till 1995. For his services to



Amateur Football he was awarded WAAFL Life Membership in 1978. He was manager of the 1979 State Carnival Team in Hobart, Tasmania. From 1985 till 1996 George was WAAFL Treasurer.

Over the seasons he was actively involved in Committees including Re-Instatement, Tribunal, Club Championship and Goal Kicking record, also was neutral timekeeper in Finals and especially Grand Finals.

Over many years George gave of his time unselfishly and enjoyed his involvement with his only reward to "just help out and keep amateur sport amateur".

He was a quiet achiever and his presence will be missed in Amateur circles.

WESTERN AUSTRALIAN AMATEUR FOOTBALL LEAGUE PRESIDENTS REPORT 1998

The 1998 Season was mainly one of consolidation with many of the previous years initiatives in place, (gradings, points not fines, no interstate football trips, use of once used footballs, delegates meetings,) and working well. Only small changes were made to the running of the League. The Umpire's Appointment Panel was revamped with Umpire's Coach Mike Ball in charge and fellow coaches and advisers fulfilling that important role. Vaughan Veryard (boundary), Nigel Tiller (goals), Dennis Miller, Des Deering, Ron Bayens, Paul Wedd are to be thanked for their efforts.

An initiative that started in 1997, our High Schools Umpire Scheme under the guidance of Bruce Wheatland was expanded with Morley High School now joining with John Forrest High School in training Junior Umpires to participate as boundary umpires in our League. We hope to extend this scheme further and some of the participants will ultimately become field umpires.

The Management Committee continues to be mindful of cost savings for all member clubs. I believe we have achieved this responsible fiscal policy without putting any of our other responsibilities in jeopardy. Treasurer Alan Thomas presented a balanced budget at the start of the year and with his efforts along with the Executive Officer, Neil Judge has produced a small deficit. In real terms there has been no real increases in costs of Amateur Football in the past three seasons. This has been achieved with the following changes made at Management Committee level;

- a) A greater grant from the Football Commission obtained through our affiliation in the Metropolitan Football League's Council,
- b) Interstate football teams no longer being selected, but have maintained our local and country inter-league clashes both at League and Colts level,
- c) deduction of points instead of fines per team penalties, Clubs seem more aware of this, however, clubs who have no chance of finals placings do not get any real penalty, this is to be reviewed.
- d) Use of once used footballs in colts, reserves and lower grade teams. This has not detracted from the game, but in most club's a substantial cost saving.
- e) The Umpires Association not placing any demands for pay increases which would have to be passed on to all Clubs. We appreciate the cooperation of the Umpires, The Umpires Association President Byron Hadjimihalakis and his committee.
- f) the League Office supplying football jumpers, shorts at reasonable costs, another cost saving for clubs.

Members of the Management Committee continued to give of their services to the League on a purely voluntary basis with little or no rewards other than one of self satisfaction. Like in other voluntary run organizations some members gave greater efforts than others due to time constraints and the particular role of their subcommittee responsibilities.

Our most visible sub-committee - media - was again under the control of Bob Stow and Alan Clement, who carried the weekly Saturday evening Amateur Radio Programme. Our other media outlet was a weekly two page spread in the Westar programme. This was aimed at the general public state wide to give readers some insight into your League.

State Football coordinator Tony Tarulli was in charge of both the Senior and Colts programme. We were successful in our senior team with coach Gary Armstrong making a great contribution with again a 100% success rate against the Country Football League combined team. Jeff Miller, Colts Coach fulfilled the difficult task to play clearly stronger teams against the Country Football League and Great Northern Football League.

Functions coordinator, David Thompson, along with Graeme Jacques had the daunting task of arranging our two premier functions, the Presidents and Secretaries Dinner and the Annual Dinner and Presentation Night. Both functions clearly showed the organizing ability of the coordinators. Their efforts did the League proud.

Long serving Doug Frame had the role of filling out and posting all panel umpire appointments (over 100 each week), organization of the ground staff for all the Leagues finals venues, plus general maintenance around the Amateur Office.

Vice President Milton Sanders carried out numerous roles with distinction and enthusiasm, where does he get the time? His role as Secretary of the Metropolitan Football Leagues Council and as President of the biggest Junior Football League in the metropolitan area gives your League first hand knowledge and coal face feed back on all sections of football that is required to make the Amateur League the important football body that it is.

Secretary Bruce Wainwright again in charge of Amateur scores for publication in various outlets, along with his normal duties on Saturdays. Other members Peter Gepp and John Morgan assisted with many given tasks in the smooth running of the League. With Peter not seeking re-election thanks are extended for his many years of voluntary service to the League.

It was with deep regret we saw the passing of our long serving board member George Livingstone (see front story).

The W.A.A.F.L. is made up of various other sub-committees operating apart from the management committee. These include weekly tribunals, reinstatements, investigations, umpires appointment board, umpire observing, Club umpires observer. These tasks are carried out without fuss and demands. I appreciate all their efforts.

New Clubs were welcomed to the League, Marangaroo, Kingsley, Mosman Park whilst Balcatta amalgamated with Osborne Park. One Club Old Guildfordians did not participate this season.

Valuable sponsorship continued from the Swan Brewery, Smith + Nephew, Schweppes and the Football Commission. New Sponsors included Burley Sekem and Granny's Pies.

My sincere gratitude to the office staff for their diligent work throughout the season. Executive Officer Neil Judge, Kerry Spencer, Diane Clausen, Jeanette Sanders and Margaret Choules continued to give efficient service, thanks to their efforts, Clubs have been provided with good attention.

Once again the W.A.A.F.L. and its member Clubs continue to run with a dedicated band of tireless workers,, without whose support and efforts we certainly would not exist as successful in providing a great community service. To all those who helped in any way and capacity this season a pat on the back ... and thank you.

It gives me pleasure to present this Annual Report. The significant change for the season was the Umpire's Appointment Board. The Board was totally independent from the Executive Committee for the first time.

The Board met every Monday Night to evaluate overall performance of all Umpires and selection. The change was a great success and further improvements are installed for Season 1999.

The other significant improvement was finding a central location for training with excellent facilities this being Richardson Park. Umpiring could use this facility for Pre and In-season training with ground condition of an excellent order. This facility was made possible by the tireless work of the Umpires Association, especially Byron Hadjimihalakis. Byron's personal input was fantastic and his enthusiastic effort helped attain the facility. Also, special thanks to the South Perth Cricket Club and Hockey Club in allowing us to jointly use these very good facilities. With the help of the Amateur League we were able to install improved lighting which will be very useful for training in Season 1999.

The training aspect improved greatly over Season 1997 and this was largely due to the appointment of Stewart Dempest as the Phys-Ed person for 1998. His effort saw an increase of numbers at training. This was due to the variety which was presented throughout the season. Also, special thanks to the Senior Umpires who helped take skill drills throughout the season.

In the Goal Umpiring category we saw an increase in the numbers and the quality of personnel. This can be attributed to the great effort by Nigel Tilley who was able to instill into these umpires that it can be very enjoyable apart from being totally serious. The group bonded together very well and they enjoyed a great social season.

Boundary Umpiring continued to improve in numbers and the standard was of a high quality. This was all possible by the professional manner in which this group was coached and the excellent work by Vaughan Veryard. The other pleasing aspect was the young umpires who were totally committed to training and the games they were appointed to.

The young Boundary Umpires from the Senior High Schools of Morley and John Forrest in the "A", "B" and "C" colts throughout the season was nothing short of excellent. Their contribution was great and a special thank you to Bruce Wheatland and Michael Papakos. These two gentlemen coached and appointed umpires to games throughout the season. I would like to personally thank Bruce Wheatland for his total commitment to improve numbers in Umpiring and generate more umpires for Amateur Football in the future.

In the Field Umpiring section we saw a great increase in our numbers. Their commitment to training, matches and Accreditation was of a high order. We saw the introduction of the Yellow and Red Card for 'order off' law this year. I believe this has worked well with further improvements for 1999 ever so small. The input by Ron Bayens and Dennis Miller was of a high standard and their feedback to umpires throughout the season was very encouraging.

To all umpires who officiated throughout the finals and grand finals especially, I would like to thank them for their performance. Umpiring on Grand Final Day was of a high order and contributed to a high standard of football.

In conclusion I would like to thank all Umpires and Board Members for Season 1998, including the Executive Committee, for their help throughout the Season so that umpiring flourished.
