- Demonstrated ability to inspire individuals and teams in the pursuit of individual and team achievement.
- Show initiative and creativity
- Understanding of SFC values.
- Ability to attend community football to assess and monitor players

Desirable

- Experience in using relevant technology appropriately in training and game day situations
- An understanding of the Talent Pathway model
- Links to or a strategy to develop networks with community clubs, coaches and players with SFC district
- Energetic, punctual and reliable
- Available for SFC promotions and club events where necessary
