

WAFC POL.22: Primary Registration Policy

POLICY BACKGROUND

This policy is developed to provide clubs with clarity over where players are to be primary registered with an overall goal to increase transparency and communication between Clubs across different competitions.

1	WAFL Futures All WAFL Futures listed players will be primary registered with their zoned WAFL Club. Players can Type 2 permit back to their Community Club of Origin for the entirety of the Community Season.
2	WAFL Colts All WAFL Colts listed players will be primary registered with their zoned WAFL Club. Players can Type 2 permit back to their Community Club of Origin for the entirety of the Community Season.
3	WAFL Senior List All WAFL Senior listed players will be primary registered with their zoned WAFL Club.
4	Rogers Cup All WAFLW listed players will be primary registered with their zoned WAFL Club. Players can Type 2 permit back to their Community Club of Origin for the entirety of the Community Season.
5	WAFLW Reserves All WAFLW listed players will be primary registered with their zoned WAFL Club. Players can Type 2 permit back to their Community Club of Origin for the entirety of the Community Season.
6	WAFLW League All WAFLW listed players will be primary registered with their zoned WAFL Club. Players can Type 2 permit back to their Community Club of Origin for the entirety of the Community Season.
7	Community Juniors All players turning 18 after July 1 in the current season who are not listed in a category above are to be primary registered with a Junior Club. Players can be Type-2 permitted to Senior competitions as rules permit.
8	Community Seniors All players turning 18 before June 30 or older in the current season who are not listed in a category above are to be primary registered with a Senior Club.
9	Club of Origin Players transferring or permitting from a WAFL Club are to be permitted or transferred to the club in which they were registered with prior to transferring to the WAFL Club. If a player is no longer eligible to play for their Club of Origin (ie. Junior Club) the player shall choose their preferred club.
10	Player Fees In acknowledging players play between multiple competitions, clubs should work together to assess how fees can be paid equitably across two clubs based on the number of games played without costing the player any more than a player who plays for one club.
