






REGISTERED PLAYERS



COST TO PLAY PER TEAM



BRIEF HISTORY

Beginning in 1922, the WAAFL is now in its 94th year. The WAAFL has grown from a small six team competition to the largest single organised football league in WA.

In 2015, the WAAFL catered for 68 clubs, 244 teams and approximately 10,000 registered players.

The WAAFL provides a quality high standard competition for players not wishing to endure the commitment to WAFL due to study or work commitments, family, or simply a lifestyle that considers football as a recreational pursuit.

Often the beginning point for many well-known WAFL and AFL players, the WAAFL provides a strong competition for those starting an elite football career and to becoming the football champions of tomorrow.

High profile players such as Phil Scott, Drew Banfield, Laurie Keene, Brett Jones and two-time Sandover Medallist Ian Dargie started their senior football in the WAAFL.

Other household names and current AFL players, include Tendai Mzungu (Fremantle) and Nick Kommer (Essendon).

The WAAFL continues to focus on the future to ensure it can meet new challenges and set new standards of excellence and relevance for member clubs.



PRESIDENT'S REPORT

With the conclusion of our 94th year the WAAFL celebrated another successful year as the largest single football competition in Western Australia. This year we had 68 clubs who competed across 25 grades and delivered a total of 2,143 games compared to 2,029 in 2014.

To be part of an organization that delivers fixtures that develops and encourages participation at various levels of ability and commitment is something that fellow board members and staff are proud of.

Our constant growth does not happen without the help and assistance from our many stakeholders and partners who make it possible. Thanks to the WA Football Commission for the office and staff facilities they provide. Our corporate partners Carlton and United Breweries, Burley, Midway Ford, West Coast Eagles Football Club, Elastoplast, Redimed, Australian Physiotherapy Equipment and Skill Hire all help us to provide football at the lowest possible cost.

The inaugural WA State Integrated Team participated in the AFL National Inclusion Carnival in Melbourne in August. The week-long carnival of football was played between all States on former VFL Grounds. Congratulations to our players David Hallows and Lindsay Ashworth who were rewarded with All Australian selection. The WAAFL are grateful to have received valuable financial support from Disability Services Commission, National Disability Insurance Agency and Redimed whose support enabled the trip to occur.

The West Coast Eagles U23 State Amateur Team travelled to Hobart, Tasmania for the Australian Amateur Football Carnival. The Team finished as carnival runners up with six Western Australian players receiving WAAFL All Australian Selection.

Thanks to everyone involved in our state team programs. Coaches, their staff and players should be pleased with their performances; to represent your state in a national competition is something to be very proud of.

Congratulations to all WAAFL Fairest and Best Winners, Leading 'A' and 'B' grade Goal Kickers, Champion Clubs, Best Club Administrator, Best State Player Award recipients and Premiership teams. You have officially written yourself into WAAFL history.

To those retiring from their football clubs either as a player or administrator, thank you for your support and unselfish service. The time and effort received from everyone across the WAAFL community throughout the year has allowed us to become a professional community based sporting organisation.

The coming season will no doubt throw up many challenges and hurdles to confront. Foremost the revamping of the bylaws in regards to allegations of payment of players, as directed by our clubs.

In conclusion, I would like to express my true appreciation to everyone involved in our 94th year. I am privileged to be part of a group of dedicated volunteers who make up the WAAFL elected board. 

INTEGRATED FOOTBALL

WAAFL Integrated Football has enjoyed a watershed year in 2015 with many highlights and achievements that have assisted this wonderful community program in becoming one of the leading recreational pursuits in Perth for people with intellectual disabilities.

The program this year featured seven teams; Warnbro Swans, High Wycombe, Kingsway, Coolbinia West Perth, Fremantle CBC Gold and Fremantle CBC Green.

Fixtures were increased to eleven games per team with High Wycombe playing twelve. The season began with other WAAFL grades on 11 April 2015.

All games are played with a focus on participation for all players adopting AFL Laws together with some modifications. The most pleasing is the continued development of all players and the spirit of good sportsmanship that exists within all teams.

A major milestone was achieved in 2015 with the inaugural WA State Integrated Football Team participating at the AFL National Inclusion Carnival in Melbourne in August. The WAAFL are grateful to have received fantastic financial support from the Disability Services Commission, National Disability Insurance Agency, AFL and Redimed which enabled the trip to occur.

Additionally, Inclusion WA and AUSRAPID provided their expertise in the area of disability classification ensuring all players met the guidelines for selection at a national event.

Led by Program Co-ordinator, Greg Gilbee and inaugural WA State Coach Jamie Wynne, the opportunity to send a representative team to Victoria provided sixteen players with a unique life time experience that many could only dream about.

The week long carnival of football was played between all States on former VFL Grounds culminating with an AFL9s exhibition match on the MCG at half time of the Carlton v Collingwood game. The week finished with a final series play off at Punt Road, Richmond on 9 August 2015.

The WA Team were fantastic wearing the Black Swan proudly on their jumpers and giving their all in every match. The team won their first game against Tasmania then defeated Queensland in the playoff for fifth place.

The Integrated Football All-Stars game as the AFL curtain raiser at Domain Stadium generously supported by the West Coast Eagles Football Club has become an eagerly anticipated event

each year by the players. This year the event was held prior to the West Coast Eagles v Carlton match on 10 April 2015. Once again all teams were represented. We took a further step this year in classifying players to provide evenness between the two teams to produce closer and more competitive games.

The Count Me In Round a joint initiative of the Disability Services Commission and the WAFL celebrating inclusion for all provided opportunities for several WAAFL Integrated Football Teams to participate in half time activities at a number of WAFL matches.

The Count Me In Round coincided with the WA State Integrated Football Team's final lead up to the AFL National Inclusion Carnival. This enabled terrific media opportunities with Channel 7's Today Tonight Program, The West Australian Newspaper and a visit to the West Coast Eagles Football Club who once again demonstrated their support of WAAFL Integrated Football including a visit by star player Mitch Brown to a State training session.

The WAAFL Integrated Football Grand Final was played on Sunday 6 September 2015 at Yokine Reserve in front of a terrific crowd. In perfect spring conditions, the game was played in tremendous spirit and true sportsmanship synonymous with this terrific program.

Coolbinia West Perth demonstrated why they have been unbeaten all season. Once again, their midfield through Lyndsy Ashworth and David Hallows drove their team forward. Ashworth in particular was outstanding with five goals playing as a midfielder.

Fremantle CBC Green was very well served by their running machine Jayden Minervini together with Sean McGowan and coach pick Regan McCoy. In the end it was Coolbinia West Perth who prevailed winning 8.7 (55) to Fremantle CBC Green 1.3 (9). In fitting with integrated tradition the player judged best afield was Anne-Marie Rich who all agreed was fantastic up forward for Coolbinia West Perth. Congratulations to Coolbinia West Perth the 2015 Premiers and winners of the Peter Grosser Perpetual Trophy.

Recognition must be given to all our clubs, coaches and passionate volunteers who give their time unconditionally. We would also like to extend thanks to the WAFC district staff, Disability Services Commission, the Department of Education and Inclusion WA who play key roles in ensuring Integrated Football remains vibrant, enjoyable and a sport that encourages people with intellectual disabilities to participate.

HALL OF CHAMPIONS

The Hall of Champions honours those individuals who have made long, significant and commendable contributions to the WAAFL to help make it the strong and respected sporting body that it is today.

On Monday 31 August 2015 the WAAFL inducted four new members into the Hall of Champions.

Brad Dunn began his involvement in the WAAFL with the Mt Lawley Amateur Football Club in 1979. In his first season he was runner up in Mt Lawley's A-Colts fairest and best, the next year he was selected in the WAAFL State Colts Team and won his first of nine premierships as a player in A-Colts.

Beginning in 1982, Dunn represented WA seven times in the WAAFL State Team and was senior coach in 2000 and 2001. He was selected as an All Australian Amateur in 1985, 1986 and 1988.

He coached Mt Lawley's A-Colts to three grand finals and a premiership in 1984 as well as coaching Mt Lawley's B Grade to a premiership in 1997. He finished his career playing 220 games for Mt Lawley and being awarded club Life Membership in 1989 and induction into Mt Lawley's Hall of Fame in 2013.

David Perry began his WAAFL playing career with the North Beach Amateur Football Club in 1985. He played 93 games for North Beach between 1985 and 1990. In 1986, Perry was selected in the WAAFL State Team to play in the Australian Amateur Football Council Carnival in Melbourne. He was WA's best player in the carnival and selected in the All Australian Amateur Team. Later that year, he was awarded North Beach's Aitken Medal for Champion Footballer and runner-up in the club's A Grade fairest and best.

He won the C.J. Jamieson Medal in 1987 and 1989. He was part of North Beach's first A Grade Premiership in 1989 and won another premiership in 1990. In 1988 he was awarded North Beach's Aitken Medal for the third consecutive year and won his club's A Grade fairest and best for the second time.

Neil Donaldson began his involvement in the WAAFL with the UWA Football Club in 1954, first as club Secretary before being elected as Vice President. He was elected President from 1963 to 1965 and coached the club's inaugural C Grade and D Grade team. Neil played 252 games and was honoured

Life Membership of UWA Football Club in 1968. His biggest legacy will be remembered as coach and mentor where he led University teams to seven consecutive grand finals, winning premierships in 1969, 1970, 1971, 1974 and 1976. In 1975 he was an A Grade selector and Team Manager.

He was awarded WAAFL Life Membership in 1972 and was awarded the National Football Council Merit Award for services to amateur football in 1990. In 2000, Neil was awarded an Australian Sports Medal from the Australian Government, and in 2003 was awarded AFL Recognition to Volunteers of Australian football. In 2012, Donaldson was honoured WA Football Commission Life Membership. In 2014, he was awarded the Medal of the Order of Australia (OAM) for his service to Australian Rules football in WA.

Keith Slater commenced his senior football career in 1954 with the Midland Junction Amateurs before being recruited by Swan Districts Football Club the following season. He played 166 games for Swan Districts and won the club's fairest and best on three occasions in 1956, 1957 and 1960. He represented WA in 21 matches in which he captained three. In 1964 after 166 games with Swans Districts, he accepted the role as Captain/Coach at Subiaco Football Club and played a further 52 WAFL games with Subiaco. He ended his career back at Swan Districts in 1967 to complete a football career totaling 239 games and an impressive 257 career goals.

During the same period, he also played test cricket for Australia. His cricket career spanned 13 years where he accumulated 2198 first-class runs and took 140 wickets.


