A brief history

Beginning in 1922, the WAAFL is now in its 92nd year. With 66 clubs, 243 teams and over 17,000 registered players, the WAAFL has grown from a six team competition to the largest single organised football league in WA, catering for players from the age of 16 years, as well as considerable volunteer personnel and social supporters.

The WAAFL provides a quality high standard competition for players not wishing to endure the commitment to WAFL training due to study commitments, career commitments or simply a lifestyle that considers football as a recreational pursuit.

The WAAFL also bridges the gap between amateur football and the champions of tomorrow, with many well-known WAFL and AFL personnel beginning their careers in the WAAFL. Former West Coast Eagles and Hawthorn Coach, Ken Judge began his coaching career at an A Grade amateur club and former Dockers coach Gerard Neesham played several seasons of amateur football and was even selected to represent the WAAFL at a state level.

Other high profile players include Drew Banfield, Phil Scott, Troy Wilson (West Coast Eagles), Gary Buckenara (Hawthorn), Shane Parker (Fremantle), Simon Beasley (Western Bulldogs), Sandover Medallists Ian Dargie (2), Alistair Pickett (2) and Shane Beros.

Former amateur players who have gone on to be senior administrators include former WA Football Commission Chairmen Dr Neale Fong (a triple A Grade Fairest and Best medallist with the WAAFL) and Dr Peter Tannock, current chairman of the Sydney Swans Richard Colless, and former West Coast Eagles Chairman and AFL Commissioner Terry O'Connor.

New logo to be introduced in 2014

HALL of CHAMPIONS

In 2013, the WAAFL inducted four new members into its Hall of Champions in front of more than 140 guests at the City West Receptions.

The WAAFL Hall of Champions was introduced in 2010 as a way to recognise the outstanding contribution to amateur football by players, coaches, umpires and administrators, as well as those who began their careers at an amateur level before going on to higher tiers.

WAAFL President John Davies said that the Hall of Champions was a unique way of honouring significant people for their unselfish contribution to amateur football over many years.

"The Hall of Champions gives us the opportunity to reflect back on the people who set the firm foundation for amateur football in Western Australia. It's a way to acknowledge the roles these men played, and the roles in progressing the work of those who have gone before us."

"It is one way the WAAFL can honour them, to welcome or remember them, to embrace them for their efforts and to add their names to the already prestigious list of people currently in our Hall of Champions." he said.

This year Brian Lambert and Charles Veryard were inducted as Champions for their extensive contribution to amateur football.

Brian Lambert began his football career with North Fremantle in 1963. From there, Lambert was selected to represent Western Australia three times in 1962, 64, 67 and played in the All Australian side in 1962, Gerry Stokes, Richard Roe (on behalf of Richard Roe), Darren Harper (on behalf of Bernie Naylor), Lionel McQueen, Vaughan Veryard (on behalf of Charles Veryard) and Brian Lambert.

1965 and 1968. Lambert was the A Grade Fairest and Best in 1962, 1967 and 1968.

Charles Veryard was a player and an official of significance. Veryard played football for both West Perth and Subiaco before taking on the Presidential Role at Subiaco from 1939 – 1941.

These same years saw Veryard head the WA Amateur Football Association as President, and again in 1946 for a further 16 years to ensure the success of football in WA.

Another two former WAAFL greats were recognised in the High Achievers category, as players who began their career at an amateur level before going on to higher tiers.

Six time WANFL Premiership player Bernie Naylor, and two time West Australian Football Association Fairest and Best Richard Roe were both recognised as High Achievers.

Also recognised at this year's Hall of Champions were Lionel McQueen and Gerry Stokes, who were both awarded Life Memberships through their substantial dedication to amateur football in Perth.

Both McQueen and Stokes have extensive history with the WAAFL, with their commitment to the WAAFL obvious through their many achievements, highlights and roles within the League.

WAAFL Integrated Football

Now in its fifth season, the WAAFL Integrated Football program continues to grow, providing opportunities for people sixteen years and over with intellectual disabilities to play football in a structured competition.

In 2013 the program consisted of six teams from five existing WAAFL clubs being Fremantle CBC, High Wycombe, Kingsway, Lynwood Ferndale and Warnbro Swans.

Team numbers have been particularly strong this season with Fremantle CBC hosting two teams who contested this season's Integrated Grand Final.

All teams competed in a fortnightly program of eight games, followed by two Semi Finals culminating in the Grand Final.

Integrated Football is an inclusive program where participants not only have the opportunity to play football but importantly become part of an Amateur Football Club with weekly training and involvement in club activities and events.

This season Fremantle CBC took their players to Melbourne for an Integrated Football experience with the Victorian based FIDA competition playing a series of games and attending AFL football at Etihad Stadium.

Throughout the course of the season initiatives were taken to raise the profile of the Integrated Program in the Perth community with a highlight being the Integrated Curtain Raiser prior to the AFL Game at Patersons Stadium between West Coast Eagles and Richmond. An in school visit was undertaken courtesy of Durham Road School where players and coaches from High Wycombe Integrated team conducted clinics for students.

An Integrated school program is seen as a fantastic way to introduce young people with intellectual disabilities to Integrated football ultimately becoming part of a development pathway to the WAAFL program.

The Integrated Football Grand Final this season was played at Steel Blue Oval, Bassendean and was hosted by Swan Districts FC who gave generously of their venue and facilities. The match was a Fremantle CBC derby between Fremantle CBC Gold and Fremantle CBC Green with both teams having enjoyed successful seasons and had faced one another only once in the season opener.

In an exciting even contest, played in fantastic spirit and before a vocal crowd, it was Fremantle CBC Gold who claimed victory winning 6.2.38 against their stable mate Fremantle CBC Green 3.4.22

Planning has begun for season 2014 with both Wembley and Coolbinia West Perth Football Clubs expressing interests in forming teams. Earlier this year Wembley FC held their first 'Come and Try' day whilst Coolbinia West Perth are gearing up for an event later in the year.

It is important to acknowledge support from the Gaming Community Trust, the Department of Sport and Recreation, Disability Services Commission, Inclusion WA and all participating WAAFL clubs and their wonderful volunteers who foster and drive the Integrated football program providing a service to the community that goes beyond just having a kick.

West Coast Eagles under 23 State Amateur Team



The West Coast Eagles State Amateur Program commenced in April this year, participating in a nine week training program before taking on the Tasmanians.

In May the West Coast Eagles State Amateur U23's faced the WA Country Football League in a tough game of football.

Playing in wet conditions and against a much bigger bodied side, WA was unable to claim the win and lost by 25 points. Best on ground was awarded to Jarrah Green.

Head Coach Daine Burnett led the squad through the program and said all eyes were focused on the big game against Tasmania.

When game day arrived, so did the wet conditions but the players were determined to make the most of the opportunity at Brownes Stadium, Lathlain.

Unfortunately for WA, the Tasmanians proved too good in the rainy conditions on the day, taking charge from the first siren.

Although WA were able to stay competitive for much of the game Tasmania broke away in the second half leaving Tasmania to take the win, and bragging rights by 21 points.

In a well fought game, Josh Stott was chosen as the WA best on ground for his impressive efforts throughout the match.

The program has seen many WAAFL players rewarded with All-Australian selection, some of which have also gone on to WAFL, and AFL clubs, including Nick Kommer, who was drafted by the Essendon Football Club in the 2012 National draft. West Coast Eagles State Amateur Colts

In 2013 the WAAFL embraced a new venture introducing WA amateur football to television through new show, Amateur Footy Time.

Developed by Local Media Services Company, AFT is the only locally produced television show that showcases senior community football in Perth.

Breakfast radio personality Steve Mills hosts the series that was introduced to keep all WAAFL clubs and the associated amateur football community up to date with what was happening in the WAAFL.

WAAFL General Manager David Armstrong said this was a great initiative for the WAAFL and one that would bring the football community closer together. "Amateur Footy Time is another step forward for the WAAFL, a move that will keep everyone engaged with amateur football," he said.

Throughout the series so far, the AFT team have travelled across the state including a trip to Bunbury to seek out all the characters of senior community football, showcasing highlights from on and off the field, going behind the scenes, and showing young and aspiring footballers how to improve their game. Series director David Macrae said the WAAFL's initiative and support of the new production had been fantastic. "We can't speak highly enough of the WAAFL and clubs for coming together to put this show to air. "Community football is the lifeblood of the sport in WA and this series will go a long way in showcasing how impressive the sport is in the community."

Not only producing AFT, Local Media Services Company will also assist the WAAFL in taking the Grand Final experience to a new level offering live online streaming of the A Grade Grand Final.

David Armstrong said that he is excited at the prospect of offering the Grand Final game to those who were unable to attend the venue.

"The A Grade Grand Final is our showcase game of the year and it's exciting that fans will be able to watch it across many platforms" he said.

As well as live streaming of the A Grade Grand Final, the A and B Grade League and Reserves, and Phil Scott and Ian Dargie Colts games will all be available for purchase. The C1, C1R and Ian Dargie Colts games will also be offered.

Umpire Report



Following a restructure of WAFC Umpiring, changes included Tim Priest as WAFC Umpire Manager Senior Competitions consulting to WAAFL.

Significantly in 2013 the appointment of Greg Gilbee as Honorary WAAFL Umpire Operations Manager proved invaluable, particularly given WAFC Umpiring staff reducing from 6 full time staff two years ago to presently 3.5.

All are indebted to Greg for his outstanding management. As key conduit between panel umpires and League administration, Greg was integral in delivering a change management plan. This plan centred on enhanced cooperation. Focus included ensuring each umpire was aware of their responsibility to professionalism on and off field.

We acknowledge the Western Australian Community Umpires Association, particularly in assisting in retain umpires through social events.

Hamer Park again proved a terrific base for umpire coaching. We appreciate Mt Lawley FC for their cooperation.

Senior umpire coaches provided tireless efforts through 2013 to instil improved panel appointed umpire performances.

Following a review and interview process, Cameron Douglas was appointed, this his first year as Senior WAAFL Field Coach. Appointing weekly in excess of 60 field umps, Cam's technical knowledge is outstanding. His embracing of WAFL umpire coaching best practice has proved invaluable. Cam's coaching includes regular use of match day vision.

Robbie McDonald was reappointed as boundary coach. Well regarded for his ability to develop young talent pathway umpires. With around 70 plus boundary appointments each week at times proving challenging, he largely meet this task.

Peter Jeffers ably lead goal umpires, with Terry Tomlinson providing solid support as assistant coach. An injection of newly recruited umpires mid-season reinvigorated the goal panel.

Senior coaches were supported by match day umpire coaches who provided mentoring to panel field, boundary and goal umpires.

Liam Warwick, an expert in the West Coast Eagles fitness team, solidly contributed in managing fitness loads to reduce injuries and optimise performance. Stalwart Des Morgan managed uniforms and statistics, whilst sports trainers assisted umpires mid-week.

Regarding club umpires, support included a comprehensive power point focusing on duty of care. Additionally, on line learning accreditation was promoted, together with two PD sessions. With WAAFL funding support, three club umpire coaches provided match day coaching of club umpires. Unfortunately, too few club umpires attended midweek club umpire PD sessions. WAAFL clubs need to drive this next season given player welfare issues.

As finals conclude, senior umpire coaches will submit nominations to the WAFC, with assessment of on and off field performances in consideration to advancing talent pathway umpires to WAFL. We will also reassess transition of junior umpires to WAAFL plus talent squad programs.

On behalf of all umpires, we wish each player all the best. Umpires, like players, make mistakes but most umpires approach matches appreciating they are important to players, irrespective of grade.
