



2023 - Starkick Design a Jumper Competition

Thank you for registering to be a part of the 2023 West Australian Football Commission – *Starkick All-abilities*, design a jumper competition for education support students. Competition Requirements

- Entries are now open and close **5.00pm, AWST, Thursday 31st August, 2023**
- Students **MUST** be enrolled within an Education Support School or centre to participate in this competition.
- Maximum **2 entries** per school.
- Entries are restricted to Students enrolled between Year 3 through Year 8
(We encourage all students to participate in the activity, however schools must undertake their own selection process to finalise the 2 entries to be entered in the competition in line with the competition rules)
- Entries must be accompanied by a short reflection on the students reasons for their design. (Teachers may assist in writing this summary, if required)
- We require the jumper design to be scanned and e-mailed with the entry form for judging purposes.

Aim:

Get students to demonstrate a sense of school pride/identity and get involved in football in a cross-curricular manner, this activity can also assist engaging those who would not necessarily excel in a traditional sports environment.

We recommend students are encouraged to pay attention to local landmarks, their school ethos and location as well as population demographics when considering their design.

Note:

Any designs that contain traditional Aboriginal artwork (sometimes referred to as “dot-paintings”) due to sensitive cultural reasons, can only be submitted if they were **created** by an Aboriginal student. Teachers are not permitted to submit any non-Aboriginal student designs that contain traditional Aboriginal artwork.
