- Links to sporting pulse
- Links to JLT Insurance (requirement to download JLT App)
- Umpires to complete "Umpires Match report", they will be provided with their own login











Competition Management App

Match Day



- Junior clubs are required to provide <u>internet</u> and an <u>electronic device</u> (Ipad, Iphone, Tablet) so that umpires can input the information
- Team Managers are responsible for making sure that Umpires have submitted relevant information
- The App will be required to be used for Yr 7 – Yr 12 competitions
- Yr 3- Yr6 will be required to submit paperwork as previously done



Year 3 Competition

- Play on from a mark is **not** allowed
- Play on from a free kick is **not** allowed.
- Jumper hold tackle only

Year 4/5 Competitions

- Play on from a mark is allowed
- Play on from a free kick is **not** allowed.
- Wrap around tackle allowed





Year 7 Competition

The Year 7 Competition will be played as per the 2015 AFL Junior Rules Flow chart except for:

- a. Soccering is permitted
- b. Boundary umpires are permitted and required
- c. Unlimited bounces permitted

Year's 8 & 9 Competitions

As per the Junior Club Manual.





All Competitions

AFL/WAFL rules apply except for:

- Kick in for behinds can only occur once the flag is waved for a point.
- No free kick for a deliberate rushed behind will apply.





Game Day Environment

<u>E-Point system</u>

- Each team will automatically be awarded 2 E-points at the commencement of each game.
- The E-Points are yours to lose.
- Final determination of the E-Point is at the discretion of the JCC Executive following consideration of match report documentation and related matters.

Loss of E-Point

- > 2 or more yellow cards are issued to the team during or after a game.
- A red card is issued during the game (player or club official).
- Any **report is made against the team**, its players or officials undertaking roles related to the team including club officials by the Umpires.





Game Day Environment (cont.)

- **By-Law 40.3-** WA Football supports a **ZERO TOLERANCE** stance against <u>any form of umpiring or officials abuse</u>.
- Any breaches of these codes will result in penalties and sanctions directed at the person responsible, the team and possibly the club.
- Spectator Breach Policy
- Report Process. P&D Tribunal
 - Standard Range of Penalties.
 - Prescribed Penalties.





Umpire Respect

- The Swans District JCC Umpire Policy is as follows:
- Before the start of play and at the conclusion of the game, all players, coaches, parent and association umpires should shake hands.
- The spirit and intention is to make sure all games are played in a competitive and fair manner.
- **By-Law 40.9-** Only the Captain or Team Manager from either team can approach an Umpire during breaks in a match, and may only do so for an interpretation of a ruling (not an argument!)





Match Day Checklist

- Ensure coaches box is marked with cones if not marked, both teams are to be on the same side of the ground either side of the interchange gate.
- If you are the first game check the oval for foreign objects.
- Ensure all fixed goal posts are padded prior to the match commencing.
- Ensure all officials are ready for commencement of match.
- Ensure the time keeper knows the correct times (incl. break times).
- Ensure paperwork is handed to the umpire prior to commencement.
- Ensure umpires receive water during breaks.
- Ensure you have the correct paperwork for the umpires at end of game.
- Youth games require interchange paperwork and/or app summary. Ensure interchange official aware of operation.
- The SDFDC Team Managers Checklist will be distributed at the close of the JCC Season Launch and will also be available on the SDFDC Presidents Kit.
