- Demonstrate structured and sequential planning program within a football season
- Ability to establish a culture of respect, continuous improvement and high performance
- Ability to establish and achieve team and individual goals
- Capacity to teach/educate/mentor/facilitate players of all abilities and ages

Football Knowledge:

- Strong knowledge of coaching techniques/strategies and modern training methods at a senior club level
- Sound understanding of skill development learning strategies
- Sound knowledge of female football structure in WA
- Capacity to develop and implement individual training programs that will maximize the abilities of all individual players

Effective Communication:

• High level of various communication skills (verbal, written etc)

Qualification:

• Preferred AFL Level 2 coach accreditation, Level 1 accreditation a minimum
