

AFL9s Minimum Centre Standards Checklist

The AFL9s Minimum Centre Standards checklist has been established to ensure all AFL9s centres are operated at a high level and compliant with WAFC requirements. The checklist can be used by a centre to ensure they deliver a high quality product, and the WAFC will use the checklist to evaluate centre compliance where required.

Minimum Standard	Compliance
A field is a minimum measurement of 35m wide x 70m long	
A central point is established and manned for all enquiries or other requirements	
All matches are played in compliance with Official AFL9s rules	
A positive game environment is displayed by participating teams	
A First Aid Kit is present at the AFL9s centre	
Sherrin AFL9s footballs are being used in all matches	
All AFL9s fields are appropriately lit	
Toilets are made available to all participants	

NOTE: The compliance to the above standards will be at the discretion of the West Australian Football Commission.

If a centre is non-compliant with any of the above standards, the WAFC will work with the centre manager to correct any issues moving forward.
