

a Life of Service to Amateurs

The Western Australian Amateur Football League lost one of their longest serving members with the passing of former Registrar Tom Naylor.

In a 64 year unbroken service to Amateur Football Tom became a legend both within his beloved C.B.C. Club as well as with the W.A.A.F.L.

When he co-founded C.B.C. Old Boys with the late Gra Grosvenor in 1933, Tom began a memorable association. (Previous to his involvement with the Old Boys he had played one season (1932) for Fremantle Ex-Scholars.) His playing career lasted for 350 games highlighted by State representation in 1936 and 1938. Tom coached C.B.C. from 1940-1954, was a league delegate 1947 till 1992, President 1959-1974, Vice President 1975-1983 and was awarded Life Membership of C.B.C. in 1955.



Tom was also awarded Life Membership of the W.A.A.FL. in 1954; was Vice President in 1961-1965; Registrar from 1969-1992 and served on the Board of Management till 1992.

In 1965 in recognition of his outstanding service to Australian Rules, the South Fremantle Football Club nominated him for the A.N.F.C. Merit Award. (Tom played in South Fremantle's Reserves Premiership in 1936 and returned to Amateurs after only eight games.)

In 1990 he received the W.A.F.C. Volunteers Award.

In 1992 in a unique gesture for his outstanding services to Amateur Football he was awarded a Bar to his Life Membership.

Tom was a great and strong advocate for the Colts competition over his whole involvement with football. His love for Colts was acknowledged by naming the Champion Colts Team Award the "Tom Naylor Trophy" in his honour.

WESTERN AUSTRALIAN AMATEUR FOOTBALL LEAGUE PRESIDENTS REPORT 1997

Without doubt the most important action to occur during the 1997 season was the implementation of the new grading format. After twelve months of debate, at a Delegates Meeting, on a motion put forward by Nollamara and in a very close vote and strong opposition in some quarters the new system was approved and seems to have met with approval. With Clubs having a choice to view their Colts, Reserves and League teams at the one ground (in A to C grade, in D grade the Reserves played before their Senior team, E, F and G Grades played as single teams). This maximised Club facilities, gave a chance for Officials to be available for more than one game. Over the coming seasons there will obviously be some small changes to improve it still. Initially it created extra work for the WAAFL Office administration and Board Members and they should be thanked for their efforts in ironing out any problems, especially in fixturing.

Another innovation was the demerit points system devised by Scarborough President Tim McCallum. Team fines were replaced by loss of points until a total of 200 points were reached then a game taken off that team. Fines in relationship to Club matters were still enforced. The new penalty system led to greater responsibility by both players and Club Officials to control their teams in various matters. This new concept will hopefully continue but with some minor changes.

The Board of Management was successful in seeing a major sponsorship deal with the Swan Brewery dependant on all Clubs using Swan Products exclusively at their Club's facilities. We look forward to the Swan Breweries extension of that Sponsorship in 1998. Cadbury Schweppes also became a sponsor of the W.A.A.F.L. with their products being used at League functions. Along with continuing sponsorship from Ross Faulkner Footballs and Smith + Nephew (Elastoplast) this has enabled the administration of your League to actively pursue cost savings. This should be a benefit to all Clubs with minimal increases in Affiliation Fees.

On the State Team front we appointed a Senior Coach from within Amateur ranks. Gary Armstrong was selected after his finals success's in past seasons and now has proved his capabilities, preparing winning teams against the Combined Country Team also the Sunday Football League(the first clash since the 1950's). The Colts State Team was again under the guidance of Bill Armstrong who again proved an ability to work with the cream of our 19's and under players with success against the Sunday Football League, Great Northern Football League and a close loss against the Combined Country Colts.

The appointment of Mike Ball as Umpires Coach and Adviser continued to uplift the standard of panel umpiring. Assisted by Vaughan Veryard (Boundary Umpires) Goal Umpires Coach Nigel Tilley and with Gary Lane as Umpires Fitness Coach, Mike Ball brought his experience as a former top AFL and WAFL Field Umpire

to assist our panel of umpires. Bruce Wheatland introduced a new and innovative idea to umpiring by conducting a Boundary Umpires Course through the Morley Senior High School. Sixteen students graduated and were allocated to our "A" Colts grade, all performing creditably. It is hoped to both continue and expand this programme. Club Umpires continued to be an important facet of our game. This year a more comprehensive pre season programme of lectures has lifted the standard of Club Umpires but there is still much work to be done in this area. Club's were permitted to play straight time in home and away games where the teams agreed that no time on was needed. Small changes like these make the running of Amateur Football much easier for Officials.

The Board of Management continued to monitor and administer Amateur Football with their "finger on the pulse" through closer club ties and listening to the concerns and ideas flowing from Delegates Meetings as well as keeping in contact with their allocated Clubs. Sincere thanks to Milton Sanders (Vice President), Alan Thomas (Treasurer), Bruce Wainwright, David Thompson, Doug Frame, Peter Gepp, Bob Stow, George Livingstone, Alan Clement, Graham Jacques, Tony Tarulli and John Morgan for their time and efforts over the past season. It has been an interesting year with keen debate and discussions at the fortnightly meetings. John Prior resigned during the year due to work commitments.

The WAAFL participates in the Metropolitan Football Leagues Council (along with Sunday FL, Peel FL, SuperRules and Women's FL) and regular meetings were held to discuss football matters and allocate WAFC funding.

During the season Office Manager Avis Beasley retired after giving long and valuable service to us. Her replacement Jeanette Sanders joins Executive Officer Neil Judge and Diane Clausen as an efficient body that continues to run the day to day business. My gratitude to them for their service.

Amateur Football serves the needs of community based districts and this requires a multitude of workers in areas that's needed for it to work and succeed. These important roles include weekly tribunals, investigation tribunals, reinstatements, umpires appointment board, various Management sub-committees, weekly 6NR presentations. I thank all those persons who helped in these matters that makes our huge organisation function properly.

Our League continues to get requests to join it with new club's showing that football at this level forms an important part of various communities spread far and wide across the Perth Area. All our Clubs can only function with many volunteers who work tirelessly for little or no reward other than being successful on the field. I would like to sincerely thank all those Officials and supporters who have helped in any way either at Club or League level.

The WAAFL and Club's are constantly faced with change as the football industry continues to change to accommodate competition with other sports, tightening sponsorship \$s, greater expectations and the pressure to accept authority in todays society. The Management of the W.A.A.F.L. hopes that we have kept in touch with Club's Officials, players and supporters in order to advance our great game.

UMPIRE ADVISER'S REPORT 1997

The 1997 season has been one of which I believe can be divided into two halves. The beginning was a time to meet and evaluate the performance of Umpires and rate them into categories they were capable and competent to adjudicate. Apart from accessing their performance it was also to meet and familiarize with all concerned and to remember their names.

The pre-season performance on the field and at training need to be commended. The attendance at training for the year was very good. The change to one night a week was only satisfactory and there's a need to request for two nights. The area which needs addressing is to find a training facility in which we can use without sharing with others.

The season saw the boundary umpires numbers increase to above 30 so we were able to appoint down to "C" grade on every weekend. The group had youth on their side and with guidance from Vaughan Veryard their performance was very commendable. Midway through the year, with the assistance of Bruce Wheatland and the Morley High School we provided boundary umpires in "A" colts and they performed well and provided great assistance to the Field Umpires.

In the Goal Umpiring area the experienced people returned for 1997 with some influx of new members. They are to be commended for their dedication and love for the game. This is one area where we need to increase our numbers. Nigel Tilley under difficult circumstances did well.

Returning to the second half of the year, it was difficult in the training area being limited to time and availability. The performance of umpires was acceptable but a need to have a more consistent performance and a better understanding of the game. One area which was pleasing was the Accreditation of Umpires. We actually had 18 umpires nominate and achieve Level One and Level Two accreditation. To the observers who helped out throughout the year, thank you, you were a great help.

Finally, the Finals series were a success story with the performance of all concerned to be of a high order. The enthusiasm of all umpires was great. The high attendance at training during the Finals series helped keep morale high, this was evident on match days.

COACHES REPORT

When presented with the opportunity to coach the WAAFL State Senior side, I broke things down into three main areas of focus from my observations of the previous years.

- 1. Commitment of the "better players" to State football.
- 2. Independent support staff especially on selection.
- 3. Player selection based on team positions.

The appointment of Byron Hadji (President of the Umpires Assoc.), Peter Hughes (Assistant Coach of West Coast) and John Zaikos (Ex State Captain) as selectors, worked successfully with effective feedback on current form and unknown talent within the top four grades of the Amateur competition.

We initially contacted the Club Coaches of the players to form the nucleus of our best possible side and 30 players attended the initial training nights at Robinson Reserve. It was evident at this stage that this group was committed, as well as their Club Coaches, to the State team being a strong force. Injuries over the next five weeks were monitored and allowed us to increase the squad to 35. I would personally like to thank the Club Coaches for their support over this period.

The passion and feeling the team had for each other lead us to two magnificent victories. The first was over the Combined Country Side by 10 goals and has been rated as one of the toughest games of State Football in many a year. The side played "hard football" and I was proud of the performance. The second game against the Combined Sunday Football League side was a long awaited clash with (in their eyes) "the best competition outside of Westar Rules". We had heard that they were confident of beating us by 10 goals but, with three key position players injured prior to the game, we won comfortably by three goals. Ιt was an even greater achievement when you take into account the fact we lost three players in the first quarter. The players kept their composure under difficult circumstances with several head high tackles from the opposition.

In summary, the State Team of 1997 was a well balanced committed side who shone through two hard games. I thank all players involved, selectors, Tony Tarulli and Milton Sanders from the Management Committee and our State Manager, David Monteleone for his great effort:

STATE COLTS

Over the last two years I have purported that the WAAFL State Colts has been a success. In 1997 the same claim will be made. Apart from our comfortable wins over the Sunday Football League and the Great Northern Football League one of the most pleasing aspects was the development and promotion of 1994-95 State Colts player Mark Gostlow (Scarborough) to this year's Senior State side. This is a true indicator of the success of the State Colts program.

There is the potential within this year's squad for some players to graduate to State Senior level (and beyond), which is one of the primary objectives of the State Colts. However, there will be many players from this year who will not go on to elite levels. It is hoped, nevertheless, that each squad member's involvement has increased their knowledge of football and has assisted in their improvement as a player.

This year the State Colts was a three game program with matches against the Wesfarmers Combined Country Colts, Sunday Football League Colts and the Great Northern Football League Colts.

Our first game against the Combined Country Colts on a Friday evening at Rushton Park was a sorting out process. For many players it was their first game under real pressure. From this game some players showed that they were able to step to the next level. Danial Hopkins (Hamersley Carine) at centre half forward and in the ruck was the stand out player for the Amateurs. He was ably supported by Josh Mann (Bullcreek Leeming) as a ruck-rover and hardworking rover, Ryan East (Dianella Morley). The other notable performance was that of '95 squad member Matt Sear (North Beach), who returned after a football lay-off in 1996.

The second game of our program pitted us against the Sunday Football League Colts. Traditionally, these have been tough, close encounters. While the game was physical we were able to win comfortably. Much of our win was set up by our strong defence led by Matt De Gruchy (Scarborough) on the half back flank. It was the back lines' constant pressure that forced the opposition into many scoring errors.

While credit has been given to our defence our offence were just as industrious. Grant Holman (North Beach), Justin Rapanaro (C.B.C.) and Troy Oldfield (Whitfords) emerged as a winning centre line. However, the two surprises were Tom Upson (Collegians) at centre half forward and Travis Coleman (Scarborough) on a forward flank who were extremely productive in front of goals.
