Award Categories

Nominations can be made in the following categories:

WA Football Volunteer | recognises an individual who has given their time and effort to support the football community. This could include helping to organise events, fundraising, or other volunteer activities.

NAB AFL Auskick Volunteer | recognises an individual who has gone above and beyond to support the Auskick program.

Community Club Coach | recognises a community Coach, Assistant Coach or Coach Coordinator who has shown exceptional leadership, commitment, and dedication to their role and the sport of football.

Community Umpiring Service | recognises an umpire who has consistently demonstrated fair play, sportsmanship, and professionalism while officiating games.

Disability Inclusion Ambassador | recognises the outstanding work of a volunteer in promoting the inclusion of people with disability in football.

Diversity Ambassador | recognises the outstanding work of a volunteer that has been able to promote inclusion for Indigenous and/or Multicultural communities in football.

AFL School Ambassador | recognises an individual who has made a significant contribution to their school community through football.

Young Volunteer | recognises an individual aged 15 - 25 years who has made an outstanding voluntary commitment over the past year and positively impacted the lives of others.

Club of the Year | recognises a football club that goes above and beyond to support its players, volunteers, families and wider community instilling a positive club culture and a safe and inclusive environment.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED

All clubs are encouraged to both nominate and promote their club volunteers in the awards.

- Nominate your clubs Committee Members who contribute their time and efforts to the club.
- Nominate those people in your club who go above and beyond coaches, managers, canteen, and those that just help out.
- Promote the awards and encourage others to nominate.
- Share the news when volunteers at your club are nominated.

Competition

Each person who is nominated in any category in the WA Football Volunteer of the Year Awards will receive a personalised certificate.

Nominees who share their certificate and tag in @WAFootball will go into the running to win a \$250 voucher which will be drawn after nominations close.


