• maintains the desired position for when the ball is in 'general play'	
 adjusts position accordingly when the contest nears the scoring line/s 	
Module 7 – Skills & Techniques	
• demonstrates basic signals under match-conditions (incl. goal, behind & touched behind)	
 maintains and checks an accurate score-card throughout the game

 demonstrates an understanding of other match officials' specific roles
