POLICY BACKGROUND

The West Australian Football Commission has developed a new Umpire fee structure with a clear focus on improving the match day environment by increasing attraction and retention rates and building a strong pathway for Community Football Umpires.

All Junior Umpire Fees will be reviewed annually as the WAFC continues to look at ways to reduce and clearly define payment levels. This will hopefully remove some of the barriers allowing for greater flexibility for Umpires to be appointed games across various levels of Community Football. From a Club and League volunteer perspective, the simplification of Umpire fees will also reduce confusion and administrative workload around Umpire payments.

The WAFC shall fix the maximum fee for umpires annually prior to the commencement of the season.

PAYMENT

Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) is the preferred payment method with 50% paid by each team. This process was successfully implemented in 2020 across most Metro Junior competitions with the intention of having every junior District adhere to this process.

In the event of a forfeit less than 24 hours prior to a game, Umpires will still be required to be remunerated, with the entire cost being paid by the team forfeiting.

As they also play the “Last Possession” rule, there is no requirement for Boundary Umpires which increases the responsibilities of the Field Umpire.</p>	<p>\$40 per Umpire</p>
