This year's President workshops will continue the same format in metro quarters to provide an interactive opportunity for clubs to provide feedback to the PFL around the current context of the league as well as prioritising our next steps.

Once all four workshops are completed, based on the data collated from both the surveys and the workshops, a range of recommendations will be made. These recommendations will be presented back to you at the end of year presidents forum for further discussion.
