All over Bar the Shouting

It is hard to believe that another year is drawing to a close. It seems like only yesterday that the 2023 events were beginning.

The Swansmen enjoyed a very busy and **VERY**, **VERY** successful 2023, especially on the fundraising front. Over \$112,000 net was raised through:

- Thursday Members Night, Chase the Ace and Raffle Wheel net \$12,000 (at the end of October);
- Cash Bonanza Raffle \$13,000 (thanks to Peter Snow for coordinating);
- Auction \$63,000 (thanks to the Committee, Ross Leipold and the Club staff and all the donors);
- Wine Wall \$6000 (thanks to Des Hardiman and Darryl Crotty for rounding up the wine);
- Home Game Winning Margins \$2,400 (thanks to George van der Meulen);
- Swansmen Lounge Home Game Bar \$5,500 (thanks to 'Bar Manager' Peter Bacon);
- Membership subs, Sponsor-A-Picket, monthly dinner meetings and fines.

This was an outstanding achievement by all involved and they should all be proud of their efforts.

These funds were returned to the Club through the annual sponsorship of a Count-Me-In Round table; 10k towards renovations to the Men's changerooms; the Women's League Best Player Awards; the Men's Leading Goal Kicking Award and the end of season donation to the Club of \$100,000 (including the Auction and Wine Wall).

The monthly dinner meetings were successful with approximately 30 in attendance each month. We heard from coaches, players and a diverse range of entertaining guest speakers including League Coach Andrew Pruyn, Dr. Kevin Smythe (Catalina Aircraft history), Andrew Embley, Nic Naitanui and Luke Shuey (Mandoon Panel), Mike Richardson (Ball legend 2023), Glen Mortimer (Retravision History and Trotting), Dr. Bruce Mullan (Pig and Livestock Scientist) and comedy magician James Diamond. A big thanks to Des Hardiman for organising the guest speaker list for 2023 and look forward to a wide range of speakers for 2024.

The Xmas Lunch was held at Kappy's Italian Trattoria in Guildford on Sunday 10th December. 48 attendees were treated to a four course Italian feast, with everyone going home a few kilos heavier. The Secret Santa present was back again with Peter Clements donning the Big Red Suit and his trusty elf Caroline Clements handing out the gifts to the Ladies.

The relationship with the Club has grown even stronger in 2023, with their assistance in the Auction and Thursday Night Members Nights being of valuable importance to the fundraising efforts. Both parties are keen to continue the strong relationship in 2024 for the betterment of the Club.
