The year didn't quite kick off as planned, with the sudden 5 day Covid-19 lockdown in February, followed by 10 days of restrictions causing a delay to the start of 2021 proceedings, it was looking like 2020 all over again. Last up were the League, with the teams playing for the Dhara Kerr Memorial Cup. Again it was a tough, low scoring first half with Swans taking the upper hand leading by 8 points at the half. The heat of the day took its toll on both sides with only one point been kicked after half time. Swans were the scorer which saw them win by 9 points. A good start to the season for them. Round two saw the Colts and Reserves take on West Perth away while the League headed to the Port city to play South Fremantle. It was a day to forget for the young Colts, only kicking one goal while their opposition booted 14. The boot was on the other foot in the Reserves with Swans kicking 10 goals to one to come away with the win. The League side also had a dominant day, keeping South scoreless for the first half and only allowing them to score one goal in the second half while booting eight for the match themselves. This see's them sit on top of the ladder with a 2/0 ratio.





On the Men's front, the Football Department has again been busy recruiting over the summer break with the key signings of Victorian pair Chris Jones and Jesse Palmer and local lad Lewis Jetta, who is returning to where it all started after 11 years in the AFL. Chris will fill in the defensive hole left by Denver Grainger-Barras while Jesse will slip into the forward line. Jetta' versatility could see him slot into a utility role. They will add a wealth of



experience to the playing stock and provide leadership to the list of emerging young talent. Adam says it is exciting to see the talent and knowledge his new recruits have brought with them from their previous clubs. The players have been hard at work on the training track over the summer under the watchful eyes of Adam and the coaching staff. There is a buzz in the air again.

The first game of the year is at home on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> April against last year's runner-ups Claremont. Get down and support the players in their first hit out of the season. Drop into the Swansmen's Lounge and renew acquaintances over a cold drink.
