## 2021 Team Sheet Requirements

Clubs must find the umpire after the game and ensure team sheet has been given the all clear. Team sheets must then be submitted online with the correct information outlined below.

Requirements before saving and finalising team sheet:

- → Coach or no official selected (if you are unable to select the coach) – refer to Coach AFL information
- → Players with the correct jumper numbers notated
- → Match results set to 0-0 for player's games to be counted on the system
- → Umpires selected or added to official's section
- ♦ Select team staff and write their role next to their name team manager/first aid etc
- → Players 'evening up' all players MUST have a permit submitted either prior to the game, or on the Monday after the game. This is so these players can be added to your team sheet before it locks on Wednesday at 4pm.

If clubs have played an 'unregistered player' (player not registered to your club or playing for your club without a permit) and haven't added the player(s) to your team sheet prior to the Wednesday after the game, your club may be subject to 'club fines' outlined in the 2021 AFLMWA By-Laws
