2018 AFL MASTERS WA UPDATE

House Keeping

Club & Committee Details:

By now most clubs should have held their AGM's and have settled on their club committee for the coming year. If there have been any changes it is important to keep your club details up to date on our existing club registration system.. To do this click on the club button on the Associations home page of http://wamastersfooty.com.au. You will need to know your club logon details. It is imperative that each club has at least 2 contacts for the association to send communications to during the year. Depending your club structure this would normally be a President/ Chairman, Vice President/Chairman and a club Secretary. An email address and a contact number should be provided.

JLT club Insurance

At the beginning of every year it is mandatory and very important for every club to renew its JLT club insurance. The process is simple and begins by clicking on the JLT Insurance link on http://wamastersfooty.com.au.

This leads you to a page with some simple instructions to follow. Please tick this box in your pre-season admin function ASAP

Whilst on the subject of insurance and pre-season, if clubs co-ordinating scratch matches amongst themselves they should let the board know so as to ensure it is sanctioned for the purpose of insurance.

Recruitment strategies

If your club has plans for a public outing to recruit players then remember the Association has several banners and

• <u>Footyweb (Sports TG)</u> With the Sports TG (now referred to as Footyweb) motion being accepted at the AGM there will need to be a bit of pre season work done to get all clubs up to speed (separate communications to follow from James Hunt). In doing so the board would like to remind clubs that in taking up Footyweb, it's primary purpose at this stage is to replace the existing registration and team sheet system. It is not envisaged at this stage to be replacing the existing web site (although it will be linked via the WA AFL Masters website). Nor is it intended to be used as a means for match day communication. The Board is looking into both of these matters separately.

Umpires

Every year we rely on the commitment of a small group of guys who are prepared to put the effort into being an umpire during the season for the benefit of all of us. Every year we need people to take up this role and would really prefer to have each club provide an umpire. This year, following the retirement of a few of our long serving umpires we really are looking to some new people committing to the cause. The good is, for those who may have not been aware it is a paid gig. The board still needs to confirm the amount but the last few years the amount has been \$65. You can put your hand up for 1, 2 or more games depending on scheduling. So what are you waiting for? The first step for newbies is to get their Level 1 Umpiring accreditation.
