PRESIDENTS REPORT 1993.

It is fair to say that the positive initiatives introduced in the last two seasons have been successful and will continue, with some fine tuning, to create a better football environment. I refer to the prescribed penalties which proved its worth to the Umpires, Tribunal and Administrators as a predetermined penalty for bad behaviour.

The Coaches Support Scheme hasn't had the required initial response from all Clubs, but the positive thinkers who did use the support offered, as well as the Coaches Newsletters, no doubt got a great deal from the scheme. Paul Rafter, our State Coach, who co-ordinated the scheme with the financial backing from "QUIT" will be looking for a greater response from Clubs in 1994 and it will be to your advantage to maximise the advice available to you.

Tom Naylor's "retirement" after 23 years as Registrar, ended a long and colourful career as a Player and Administrator for us. He was awarded a Bar to his Life Membership at a dinner in his honour.

Current economic pressures have left a few Clubs struggling financially but overall most Clubs remained viable with some returning a healthy profit. It is a credit to Club Administrators who have worked very hard to raise funds without letting standards slip and I offer them all my congratulations. 1994 is going to be a year of challenge to the Clubs who were promoted to higher grades to maintain their position and go on from there. The Clubs who lost ground should also work hard to return to a position in a higher grade and this attitude will create a very healthy competition.

Preparation has begun for the 1994 A.A.F.C. Carnival in Melbourne and players will need to prove that they have the commitment and desire to be part of the team with the aim of consolidating our position as an integral part of the football community.

For the volunteers who served in positions on Tribunals, Reinstatements, Investigations and State Football I offer my sincere appreciation for jobs very well done.

To the Committee of Management, who work very hard and long, I take this opportunity to thank you all for your efforts, your achievements and your commitment.

Neil Judge, Avis Beasley and Diane Clausen yet again proved to be an efficient and dedicated administrative team and we are truly indebted to them for their work.

A special note of thanks must go to our Sponsors who have continued to support us and help us in our future planning for success.

The strength and future of Amateur football relies solely on each persons commitment and dedication within every Club. To do your best and maintain a high standard of honesty and pride in our competition is all I can ask.

The Board met frequently during the season and then met weekly leading up to the finals. Our job of selecting the Grand Final Umpires was made even more difficult because of the overall quality of our panel.

During the season about 80 field and 30 boundary umpires received appointments. I am also happy to report that 24 field umpires and 2 boundary umpires under went Level 2 AFL Accreditation. Increased numbers also allowed us to appoint two field umpires in 'C' Grade, 'A' Colts and 'B' Colts.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

This season saw a reasonable increase in our umpiring panel because we were able to offer more two umpire appointments. Th Board feels this is the best way to increase our numbers over the coming seasons and we have, therefore, asked the Management Committee to budget for an increase in Umpires Fees in 1994 so that two umpires can be used as often as possible.

CONCLUSION

It is my belief that season 1993 was one of our best and this was due in part to our Adviser, Bryan Smith, having had season 1992 to get acquainted with our system, carrying on with his ongoing development plan. Also the great work put in by our Assistant Adviser, Jim Turley, and Goal Umpires Adviser, Phil Thompson.

With the re-appointment of Bryan and Jim for Season 1994 we can look forward to another successful year.

Finally, thanking the members of the Umpires Board for their hard work and support and also Keith Spencer and Matt Dillon for their valuable assistance on behalf of the Umpires Association.

MAS HASSON Chairman COACHING PANEL

This report refers to field and boundary umpires only.

NUMBERS

About 80 field and 30 boundary umpires received appointments in the year. While total numbers remained approximately the same as last year the quality of umpires was much improved. This was due in part to the appointment of a number of youger umpires who quickly developed into competent practitioners, and in part to the fact that 24 field and 2 boundary umpires under went Level 2 AFL Accreditiation.

We were fortunate to receive a few older, experienced umpires from other competitions who swelled the ranks at A and B Grade level.

Increased numbers allowed us to appoint two field umpires in C Grade, A Colts and B Colts. Clubs appeared to welcome this development.

ACCREDITATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

Accreditation was an important part of umpire development. Theory classes were held throughout the year and each umpire was assessed by a number of observers in the field. This process had the overall effect of not only teaching novice umpires but also refining the skills and knowledge of experienced umpires. The opportunity of sending a member of the panel to adjudicate in a WAFL Reserves game was an excellent method of lifting the performance of the top 10 umpires who benefitted from feedback on that umpire by the WAFL's

Director of Umpiring. All umpires benefitted from an increased emphasis upon skills at regular training nights and from round table discussions afterwards. FINALS

All finals appeared to be conducted without the trouble of previous years. The League is to be congratulated for this. It was a difficult decision to appoint umpires to senior finals this year because of the increased depth of ability and eveness of performance of the top 10 umpires. This augers well for the future as it places pressure on that top group to perform. RECRUITMENT

A successful newspaper advertising campaign at the beginning of the season was responsible for the recruitment of a number of umpires. This needs to be continued.

Additionally, ex-players are seeking to become umpires and this should be encouraged.

Ideally, all Grades should have the opportunity of two umpires. To achieve this recruitment and retention of current umpires should remain a priority.

SUPPORT

I would like to thank Neil Judge and his team in the office for the support they have given. Additionally, the work of Max Hasson and the Appointments Board has helped tremendously in making 1993 a successful year.

CONCLUSION

I believe that the overall standard of umpiring has improved this year. While there are still too many "phantoms" (that is, those who do not attend training and therefore miss out on instruction) in the middle grades the top umpires have improved and younger umpires are making their impact. It is from this latter group that the future top umpires will emerge. The only major problem facing umpiring is the inability to supply two field umpires throughout the grades. It seems strange that the top and bottom grades (through the appointment of "club umpires") can run a two umpire system but the middle grades miss out. The answer to this is better recruitment of "official" umpires or the lessening of the numbers of grades umpired by "official" umpires.

BRYAN SMITH October 1993 In 1992 as a Subcommittee we devoted much of our effort toward either the introduction of new and exciting initiatives or consolidating others relevantly new to the system. Although still involving a great amount of effort, 1993 has proven to be a far less glamorous year. In the previous twelve months much of our time was spent on Prescribed Penalties, the Observers System and the Coaches Support Scheme.

Our main focus in 1993 was to try and identify any of those areas where the League might improve efficiency, save money or raise the standard of football. The first two areas will alleviate the need for large increases in future affiliation fees and therefore create a saving for Member Clubs. A two day study tour of Victoria and South Australia was undertaken. We tackled in excess of 30 topics in 48 hours. Upon our return a report entitled "Initiative '92" was soon tabled. The 47 page document contained 27 various recommendations which ranged from Sponsorship to Instruction Folders for Club Secretaries. I am pleased to report that over 20 of these recommendations have now been dealt with.

Further to the above we have spent many hours studying League Ladders, Relegation and Promotion Systems and Bylaws from all states. Our drive to do so has again come from having a serious attempt to solve two age old problems. The first being that of newly promoted 'A' Grade Sides struggling in their first year to avoid relegation. Secondly, the real or perceived imbalance of single team Clubs causing an uneven competition or having an unfair advantage. In summary it is fair to say that we now know what not to do. And at the present time the Committee cannot agree on a formula for restructure.

Thanks to my assistant John Davies for his sacrifice of a great deal of time and a tireless effort. I also extend my appreciation to all Club officials, delegates and members who assisted me in my duties for the Amateurs over the last eight years.

Good Luck to all sides from every Club for the 1994 Season and to the new Chairman of Operations.
