GROW

Recruit Umpires from traditional and diverse backgrounds because the bigger the base the higher the pinnacle.

TRAIN

Provide learning opportunities for all of our Umpires.

TRANSITION

Allow our Umpires to be the best they can because one in two of our Umpires want to progress to a higher level. RETAIN

Keep our Umpires engaged for longer through inclusive and enjoyable environments.

We believe the development of fundamental umpiring skills builds confidence. We concentrate on developing relevant skills for umpiring junior football and support our Umpires to gain experience.

4) We are mentors.

We develop supportive relationships with our Umpires. We are role models and positively influence each other through leading by example.

5) We take a tailored approach.

Umpires are engaged when coaching and training benefits the individual's development. We provide different experiences that grow the Umpire on and off the field.
