#### A BRIEF HISTORY

Beginning in 1922, the Perth Football League has grown from what started as a small six team competition to the largest single organised football league in WA.

In its 98th year with 67 clubs, 261 teams and 11,524 registered players, the Perth Football League caters for male and female players as young as 16 to provide a quality high standard competition whilst accommodating considerable volunteer personnel and social supporters.

For many players the, Perth Football League provides a competition for those not wishing to endure the commitment to WAFL training due to study, career or simply a lifestyle that considers football as a recreational pursuit.

The Perth Football League is also the beginning point for many well known WAFL and AFL personnel, starting their careers in amateur football and becoming the football champions of tomorrow.

#### PRESIDENT'S REPORT

On behalf of the Board I would like to welcome you to today's Grand Finals. This year has seen continued evolution of our competition, with the introduction of a Player Points System and rebranding to Perth Football League. The rebranding providing a clear pathway for club footballers across the metropolitan area — from junior and youth competitions into the Perth Football League.

To the 11,524 registered players from 261 teams who represent the 67 Clubs that took part in the Perth Football League this season thank you for ensuring our league is the predominant senior community football competition in WA.

After the successful introduction of our women's competition in 2018, this season saw a third grade introduced, with an incredible 25 teams now providing inclusive environments for more than 1200 female footballers in 2019. Their season culminated last weekend — with the A, B and C Grade premierships won by Curtin University Wesley, Nollamara and Piara Waters respectively.

Congratulations also to Coolbinia on the 2019 Integrated premiership. This competition is one of the cornerstones of the league - exactly what community football is all about - providing an opportunity for people of all abilities to represent their club with pride.

The WA Football Commission recently commissioned a comprehensive analysis of the social return on investment of club-based football - which found that for every dollar of input the football industry produces \$2.16 worth of economic

and social benefit for WA — ultimately delivering more than \$225m attributable social benefits — an average of \$3,000 of social benefits per footy club member directly related to being involved in club football each season.

These benefits include physical and mental health, suicide prevention and support networks, social inclusion and connectedness, reduced recidivism, education and economic benefits, job matching and increased productivity. The incredible social return of football — in particular among our 67 senior community clubs — is made possible by the incredible efforts of volunteers who collectively contribute 2.2 million hours to support their clubs each year.

While today celebrates our best teams, before we do it is important to acknowledge the tireless efforts of all those volunteers who toil week after week - for nothing but the love of football and their clubs - who truly define our League.

The hard work of volunteers is augmented and amplified by the terrific support that we continue to receive from the WA Football Commission in collaboration with the State Government, as well as local governments and corporate partners Carlton and United Brewers, Midway Ford, West Coast Eagles, Burley, Australian Physiotherapy Equipment, Life Without Barriers and Skill Hire — who sponsor our finals series.

We look forward to seeing you on football fields across Perth again for our 99th season next year, building into our centenary celebrations in 2021.



## WEST COAST EAGLES STATE COLTS AMATEUR TEAM

The West Coast Eagles State Colts Amateur Team took on the WA Country Football League Colts on Friday 31 May.

From the first quarter the West Coast Eagles State Colts Amateur Team dominated the play with several inside fifty's early on. The Perth Football League colts were rewarded for their efforts in the second quarter as they hit the scoreboard kicking four goals and five behinds. The Country colts kicking their one and only goal for the match just before the half time siren.

The third and fourth quarter continued to be one-way traffic for the Perth Football League Colts as they piled on another ten goals to win by 94 points, claiming back to back Neil Judge Shields.

The final quarter saw the country side with momentum but it was a little too late as the West Coast Eagles State Amateur Team won by nine points to take home the Kevin Duffy Shield.

The side also played the Victorian Amateur Football Association on Saturday 6 July at Fremantle Oval. The side fought hard in wet and muddy conditions and led by a goal at the first break. The VAFA fought back leading at every break after the first term to defeat WA by 31 points. Ned Brennan was voted by the VAFA as WA's best player.

#### INTEGRATED FOOTBALL

The Perth Football League Integrated Competition welcomed the Mandurah Mustangs to the League in 2019. The Mustangs became the ninth club to join, taking the total number of teams to ten.

This year the competition was proud to announce a partnership with Life Without Barriers. Life Without Barriers are a leader in servicing clients from diverse cultural



and social backgrounds. Both organisations support a shared vision to promote inclusion in sport for people with intellectual disabilities.

On Friday 19 April two teams from the competition were given the chance to play at Optus Stadium in a curtain raiser. This year's match was a 'North v South' showdown as clubs north of the river played those based in the south. The curtain raiser was a chance to showcase Integrated Football to the wider community as well as giving the players a chance to step onto the hallowed turf.

The season culminated with the Grand Final on Saturday 7 September at Wembley Sports Park. Coolbinia defeating Willetton by 38 points to win their fifth Integrated Premiership in a row. Willetton's Tyson Worthington was named best on ground for his efforts in the midfield.



#### INTEGRATED STATE TEAM

Sixteen players from across the Integrated competition competed at the AFL National Inclusion Carnival held in Blacktown, NSW.

The week-long carnival ran from 15-20 July with Western Australia making the Grand Final in the Pool B division. Unfortunately, the side couldn't back up last year's premiership going down to Queensland by 30 points.

Three players from Western Australia were selected in the All Australian squad with David Hallows and Lyndsy Ashworth (Coolbinia) and Tyson Worthington (Willetton) chosen based on their demonstration of the AFL's values, Play to Win, Play Fair, Play with Passion and Play as One Team.

This is the third time David Hallows has been rewarded with All Australian selection (2015, 2018, 2019) and was chosen as a forward this year while Lyndsy Ashworth was chosen in the midfield and makes his second All Australian Squad after making the side in 2015.

Tyson Worthington made his debut as a state player in 2019 and was selected in the All Australian squad as a midfielder.

For the first time the All Australian squad will travel to Brisbane to take part in an exhibition match at the 2019 INAS Global Games in October. Held every four years, the INAS Global Games is the largest sporting event for elite athletes with intellectual disability.





#### HALL OF CHAMPIONS

The Hall of Champions was established in 2010 to recognise individuals who have made significant contribution to amateur football in Western Australia since inception in 1922.

The Champion category honours an individual who has made a long and significant contribution to the amateur league, with tireless voluntary work in various capacities for the love of the game often without seeking public recognition or reward.

Our High Achiever category honours an individual who commenced their football careers at club level within the Perth Football League and continued on to carve out greatness across the many levels of football.



#### **MILTON SANDERS**

Milton Sanders began his involvement in amateur football in 1979 with the Mount Hawthorn West Perth Amateur Football Club. He held various roles on the committee between 1979 and 1991.

For his service, Milton was awarded Life Membership of the club in 1987.

Milton joined the then Western Australian Amateur Football League Board in 1987. He was elected as Vice President, a position he held for nine years. While on the Board, Milton was involved with numerous sub-committees and the State Teams.

Milton represented the Western Australian Amateur Football League on the Australian Amateur Football Championships Committee in 2000.

From 1996-2006 Milton was Secretary/ Manager of the Community Football Council Inc (formerly Metropolitan Affiliates Football League)..

Milton has received various awards from the AFL and the WAFC for his service to Australian Football.

Milton was awarded Life Membership of the League in 2002 and WAFC Life Membership in 2018.

PETER GROSSER

Peter Grosser has been involved with the North Fremantle AFC for over 48 years as a player, coach and administrator. Peter played 200 games for the club and was a State Amateur Team Representative in 1973, 1974 and 1975. He won the North Fremantle B Grade Best and Fairest in 1974 and the WAAmateur Football League B Grade Best and Fairest in 1976.

He served on the WA Amateur Football League Board from 2002-2012. Peter was involved with State Amateur Teams as State Coordinator from 2004-2012. He was the Tour Manager for the Australian Football Council Team to Ireland in 2005, 2008 and South Africa in 2010. He was the WA representative on the All Australian U23's Selection Panel in 2013 and was the Assistant Team Manager for the AFL National Inclusion Carnival in 2015.

Peter was the driving force behind the formation of the Integrated Competition for players with intellectual disabilities. The Integrated premiership trophy is named the Peter Grosser Cup in his honour.

Peter was awarded with Life Membership of the North Fremantle AFC in 1985 and again in 2006 with a Life Membership Bar. Peter was made a Life Member of the League in 2016.

#### **BOARD UPDATE**

The West Australian Football Commission recently launched the most comprehensive study ever into the economic and social benefits of local football to the WA community.

Completed by ACIL Allen, the report assesses the social and economic impact of club-based football in WA and provides a measurement tool that will enable the WA football to track social impact on an annual basis.

In an industry-first, the report uses club-based participation as the key metric to quantify the social returns of the entire industry, which identifies that the broad range of community benefits from WA football include:

Every dollar spent by club-based football in WA creates two dollars of economic activity.

- WA footy generates over \$220 million in economic benefits to WA.
- \$110 million is spent directly, including almost \$16 million on supplies and services.

For every person employed by football directly, another job is created in the community.

- In total, the equivalent of more than 1,400 full time jobs are generated by football across WA.
- With the people employed by football directly also spending their money locally, the jobs created by football extend even further.
- This creates jobs in industries as diverse as health, catering, cleaning, photography and grounds management.



Club-based footy generates an additional \$225 million in social benefits to the community each year.

- The research shows that being part of a footy club provides participants with the equivalent of \$3,000 worth of social benefits in areas such as mental and physical health and personal well-being.
- Football is a sport that connects communities like no other, with 22 players and their families and friends interacting as part of the same team each week.
- Participants are physically active for almost three hours per week each year even more than the 150 minutes recommended by the Heart Foundation.

Perth Football League General Manager David Armstrong said that we all knew the great benefits of community footy that go beyond just the game each weekend.

"The Perth Football League is a place to be active and connected to a community though a club which has mental health benefits."

#### TOP PLAYERS RECOGNISED AT LEAGUE AWARDS

On Monday 9 September the Crown Ballroom was filled with over 900 guests to celebrate the 2019 Perth Football League season.

North Fremantle's Ryan Cook claimed the nights top award, the CJ Jamieson Medal as the A Grade's Best and Fairest player for 2019.

After retiring from the WAFL last season Cook joined the Perth Football League this season finishing with 18 votes across seven games including five best on ground performances.

Cook finished one vote ahead of Trinity Aquinas' Jamie Birrell who has finished third for the award on three occasions (2012, 2014, 2018). Scarborough's Scott Worthington rounded out the top three in A Grade, finishing with 14 votes.

Whitford's Troy Skilton took out the TR Howard Medal for the first time as the B Grade Best and Fairest player. Skilton polled four votes more than the rest of the grade with five players finishing in second place.

Trinity Aquinas' Mason Nicolaou claimed the highest colts honour to win his first NK Donaldson Medal as the Phil Scott Colts best player.

Nicolaou polled 22 votes across ten games finishing seven votes clear of Fremantle CBC's Joseph Eardley.

The second season of the Women's competition saw Rossmoyne's Emily Burton take out the Women's A Grade best and fairest medal. Warnbro Swan's Kerrilee Brown was awarded the B Grade medal while Swan Valley's Kayla Augustynek was the C Grade winner.

The Men's A Grade Leading Goal Kicker award went to Kingsley player James Del Borrello who kicked 52 goals for the year. Curtin Uni Wesley's Cory Dell'Olio and Ben Saunders both won the B Grade Leading Goal kicker award with 56 goals each for the year.

The Ron Webster Memorial award for the senior champion club was awarded to Curtin Uni Wesley Football Club who had an impressive year with their league, reserves and colts' sides all making finals. The TK Naylor award for the colts champion club was awarded to Bullcreek Leeming. The champion club awards are calculated by both on and off field points with points awarded for each win, meeting attendance, payments, paperwork submitted on time. Points are deducted for send offs and for match day fines.

The LA Tetley award for best player of the 2019 State Program was awarded to Ned Brennan from Fremantle CBC.

Colin Priddis from the Scarborough Football Club won the Administrator of the Year while Whitford's Adam Salecic won the Ken Armstrong Senior Community Coach of the Year Award.
