Summary:

 'Interchange' app Year 3 – Year 12 matches in season 2021

Action:

- Ensure each team has access to compatible device to run an Interchange App
- Interchange report to be submitted after each match by Team Managers / designated Interchange Steward from the App via email

Background

The WAFC Rules and Regulations – Policy 04 states:

Each team is required to track player game time utilising an app or program prescribed by the competition.

2021 season

The use of an interchange recording app will be mandatory in season 2021 for all Teams – Year 3 to 12 within the Northern Conference and Claremont, Subiaco, West Perth Districts.

Interchange reports are initially to be sent to Club Registrars (or nominated delegate from the club), who in turn will send all Interchange Reports for all teams in the one email to below email address:

Year 3 – 12 Northern Conference: <u>interchange.north@wafc.com.au</u>

All interchange reports are required to be submit by 5:00pm the day after the match has been played. Failure to submit the interchange report by the required deadline may result in penalties such as E-Point loss or fines. This is up to the discretion of the Metro North Competitions team.

Clubs have the option to choose from two Interchange Apps in season 2021.

Interchanger – AFL

This app is available free of charge for all year 7 - 12 Male and Female Teams in 2021 WAFC Commission will cover the cost for clubs for these age groups only in 2021. Year 3 – 6 teams will be charged at a rate of \$5.00 plus GST App is integrated with Rookie Me for coaches.

Clubs wishing to utilise this app are required to complete the attached registration form and access to the app will be emailed.



Currently only available on an iPad but plans to integrate to android devises from season 2022 are in place.

This will be the WAFC preferred app to use in season 2022 and beyond.
