PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The WPFC is the oldest club in WA football. It's won the second highest number of WAFL premierships and has one of the greatest traditions in WA football history.

The names of our great legends stand out, including: Harold Boyd, the 2nd Sandover Medalist in 1922; Stan 'Popsy' Heal; Brian Foley (who won the Sandover Medal in the year I was born in 1959); Polly Farmer, games record holders; Bill Dempsey, Mel Whinnen, Les Fong, Alan Watling; latter-day heroes like John Dimmer, Robbie West, Paul Mifka Darren Harris and current stars like Aaron Black. And of course, my fellow colleague and vice president Ross Kelly 1960 premiership player, 6th in the Sandover that year and inaugural Dockers Chairman.

This great club was on the brink of extinction in mid-2018. As a former West Perth district junior (Nollamara JFC), Colts captain (1978), league player (1985-86) and board director (1992-93), I like many people was confused as to how a great club like ours could get into this position. And everyone, our members and fans who love the club deserve answers. The new board which was appointed in September of this year is still unravelling much of that. We have inherited a situation not of our making, and we are disappointed that many creditors will lose significant amount of money.

This is not the West Perth way, and for that we apologise. Our task is to ensure it doesn't happen again. We will learn the lessons from the past and changes will occur. But the main message from our board is this: **UNITED WE STAND. DIVIDED WE FALL. TOGETHER WE CAN.**

The Club acknowledges the state government and other significant groups who agreed for the Deed of Company Arrangement (DOCA) to enable the club to survive.

Phil Jackson the legendary coach of the Chicago Bulls talks about the great Michael Jordan. Jordan was the NBA's top scorer in his first 6 seasons and by far the best player in the league. But he'd never won a title. "A great player can only do so much on his own", Jackson would say. He quoted the poet Rudyard Kipling repeatedly to the team: The strength of the pack is the wolf and the strength of the wolf is the pack. When Jordan retired in 2003, he had won six championship titles and was voted MVP in all those finals. He achieved individual and team success.

So, the simple message is this. For the WPFC to remain great, and to get off the canvas, it requires everyone – our legends, members, supporters, sponsors, players, support staff, older Cardie die-hards and young Falcon fans – to unite and come together.

Over the next 12 months we need you now more than ever before. The club has been given a reprieve, a chance, to get its off-field act together. We have immediately engaged with our sponsors and will treat them as partners to maximise the mutual benefit.

And we will reinvigorate and work hard at our district level, where we already have thousands of boys and girls involved, to ensure they become an enduring part of the club's current and future story.

In the longer term we will look to forming a future fund with separate trustees, which through wise investment will hopefully provide a better financial base for operational and strategic activities.

I am confident our new board in their portfolios, comprising Ross Kelly (Vice President), Sam Modica (Finance), Peter Cutler (Football), Jim Caffieri (Sponsorship), Paul Murray (Communications) and Brett Raponi (Membership), will work hard and long to gather as many people to assist in our journey forward.



I acknowledge the great work by so many people in our Women's teams (Dave Burton), Past Players and Officials, the Talent Development pathways (Chris Erikson) and workers at the District level. All of these and many unnamed wonderful volunteers make the West Perth Football Club live, and we look forward to their continuing involvement

Looking back, congratulations must go to our former senior coach Bill Monahagn and his coaching and support team for Season 2018. To get to a Grand Final in the circumstances was remarkable. As a 10-year, record-making coach the club salutes Bill.

To our new CEO Linda Hamersley who took the reins in February of this year and steered the ship through unbelievably turbulent waters along with her very small band of staff members and volunteers, thank you.

To Geoff Valentine our new senior coach and Football chief Steve Trewhella, and all the returning and new players and staff, our members are excited about the enjoyment and success that you will bring us in the coming year.

To all West Perth followers, sponsors and members, the Board wishes to reiterate its grateful thanks for sticking with our great Club. We are excited about the 2019 Season and confident that we have a secure and strong future before us. But we need you on board, as part of the Falcons Team in 2019.

CEO'S REPORT

Reflecting on 2018, there is no doubt it has been a watershed year for the Club with many challenges faced. Significant events this year included: moving into our new facility; welcoming a new management team; entering Voluntary Administration; and, despite the off-field turmoil, reaching the WAFL Grand Final.

NEW FACILITY

Our new facility was officially opened on Saturday, 4 November 2017 by Sport & Recreation Minister, Mick Murray. The staff moved in on 20 December 2017 but it has not all been smooth sailing.

A burst water pipe in late February (my first day on the job) caused considerable damage to the first-floor ceiling, reception and theatre areas. Given it was two weeks before hosting the JLT Dockers v Eagles match, this caused considerable disruption to our preparations.

We promptly rectified the problems and successfully opened the facility for the JLT match, and our first game day activities. Over the course of the season, we learned much about what worked and what didn't with regard to Club activities. We know there is still much to be done to make the facility feel like the home of the West Perth Falcons.

This is a "work in progress" and we will continue to work in this regard during the upcoming season.

On a pleasing note, as we neared the end of the Club's financial year, we were granted a Liquor Licence, which puts us in a good position to start the new season.

CLUB MANAGEMENT

The Club's management completely changed this year with all staff being appointed between November 2017 and May 2018.

The staffing structure was created to cater for the changing face of our business, in that we now have a state-of-the-art facility to run and what comes with that is maintenance planning and staff rostering around functions and events.

Despite the steep learning curve, our new team managed to deliver nine President's Luncheons (one of which included a Mel Whinnen special memorabilia auction), the AFL Players Panel Lunch and Auction, along with a number of other club-based activities. This would not have been possible without the assistance and guidance of the great people who work around the Club.

VOLUNTARY ADMINISTRATION

The most significant event to occur this year was the Board's decision to enter into Voluntary Administration. This decision was not made lightly and came after exploring all options for obtaining a loan from the West Australian Football Commission.

On 24 July, KordaMentha were appointed as Administrators with the first Creditor's Meeting being held on 3 August 2018. At the Second (Reconvened) Creditor's Meeting on 4 September 2018, KordaMentha proposed a Deed of Company Arrangement (DOCA) which estimated unsecured creditors would receive 4 cents in the dollar and staff superannuation and entitlements at 100 cents in the dollar. The creditors voted to accept the DOCA, rather than liquidate the organisation. On 14 September, the Administration officially ended.

As I am preparing this report for the membership, there are still loose ends to be finalised with the Administrators, but the Club is operating out of Administration and the powers of the Board have been restored.

FALCONS FIGHTING FUND

Clubs survive on their loyal volunteers and supporters. West Perth was not in short supply of generous supporters when we reached out and asked for donations to ensure the Club could continue to operate post Administration.

I would like to extend the gratitude of the Club to each and every person who donated to our Falcons Fighting Fund.

Look out for the new "Falcons Fighting Fund Honour Board" when you visit the Club in the upcoming season, where donors' names will be displayed as a permanent reminder of their support to the Club in such a troubling time. New contributors will have their names included on the Honour Board.

GRAND FINAL

With all the distractions in and around the Club during the year, our players took up the challenge and did what they needed to do, which is perform on the park, and they made it through to the Grand Final. Each and every player should be proud of their achievement.

What an opportunity to be the first of the two WAFL Clubs to play at the new Optus Stadium. Of course, the players didn't do this on their own and every support person should be acknowledged and thanked for the part they contributed during the season.

FUTURE CHALLENGES

The coming years will be telling for the Club.

Our primary challenge is to not become complacent. The Club is not in a strong financial position, yet, and we need everyone around the Club to assist in every way they can to contribute to making the Club financially strong again.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

In closing, I would like to take this opportunity to thank the outgoing Board Members who supported me while uncovering the Club's precarious financial situation.

To the new Board Members, who have taken up the mantle of ensuring the Club can become financially sustainable into the future, I look forward to working with you.

The Club's staff have formed a close-knit team and we have worked to support each other and I thank them for their contribution in a difficult environment.

Being new to the football industry, I would also like to thank all those who have guided me through the course of my first season with the Club, your generous support is much appreciated.

FACILITY REPORT

In 2018 the West Perth Football Club assumed operational management of new \$8.1m facilities in Joondalup. As a venue the facility hosted more than 22,000 patrons across match day and non-match day content in its first year.

This included the Fremantle Dockers AFL pre-season game, the City of Joondalup Staff Conference, a diverse range of corporate and community functions and Falcons home finals.

It was a testing start to the year with the building's Level 1 ceiling collapsing due to a burst water pipe just two weeks prior to the venues first piece of significant content. Repairs and cleaning were completed in time with operations recommencing in March.

A key focus throughout the year was establishing venue operations and ensuring the Club's compliance with key stakeholders, VenuesWest and the City of Joondalup, were met and public facility regulations adhered to.



2018's KEY ACTIVITIES

- Draft and implement event management and delivery processes required to manage a large facility
- Conduct staff and volunteer training and season inductions

Operations

- Create supply agreements
- Establish stock ordering systems and management
- Set up digital stock management and control
- Coding of Point of Sales (POS) and development of reporting systems
- Set up of membership database and link to POS
- Set up of merchandise and online store integration

With the Club operating in a new environment and having not operated its own facility for more than 25 years, the key activities above were ground up development projects.

Commercially this year was challenging with the facility ill-prepared to commence trade at commissioning and handover. An absence of operating plans, liquor licence, and a downturn in the market diverted resources in quarters one and two. Furthering to the issues, the Club was unable to be competitive in the function's marketplace initially due to ongoing issues and lack of capacity with the Audio-Visual build in the facility which was found to be below a standard required by the functions market.

The announcement of the Club entering into Voluntary Administration and the associated publicity caused concern from local business regarding brand association to the Club and resulted in cancelled bookings and reduced interest in the hireable facilities.

An upgrade to the facility Audio Visual System was made in August after VenuesWest agreed with the Club's business case and allocated over \$35,000 to make the system fit-for-purpose.

With the operations and facility set up complete, a new commercial strategy is in place for 2019, ensuring we continue to focus on areas of greatest revenue including delivering business opportunities that optimise facility usage, commercial partnerships, outsourced catering services and generally maximising financial returns for WPFC.

MEN'S FOOTBALL



The 2018 season produced strong on-field results from our Senior Football program. 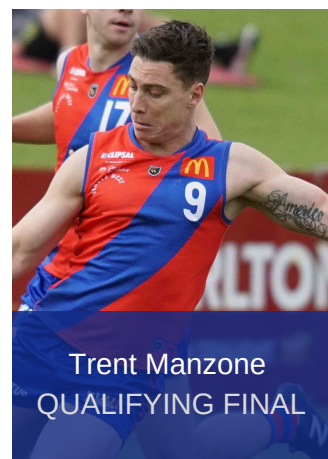

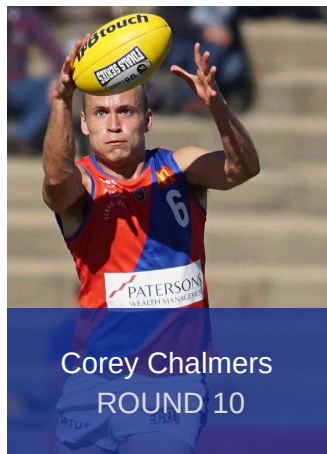

COUNTRY DEVELOPMENT (Yilgarn Falcons)

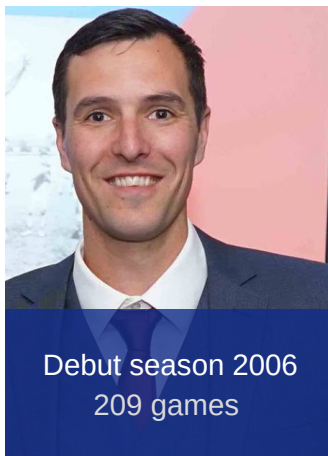
