As part of a broader focus on aligning titles with the work being delivered, several roles have been updated:

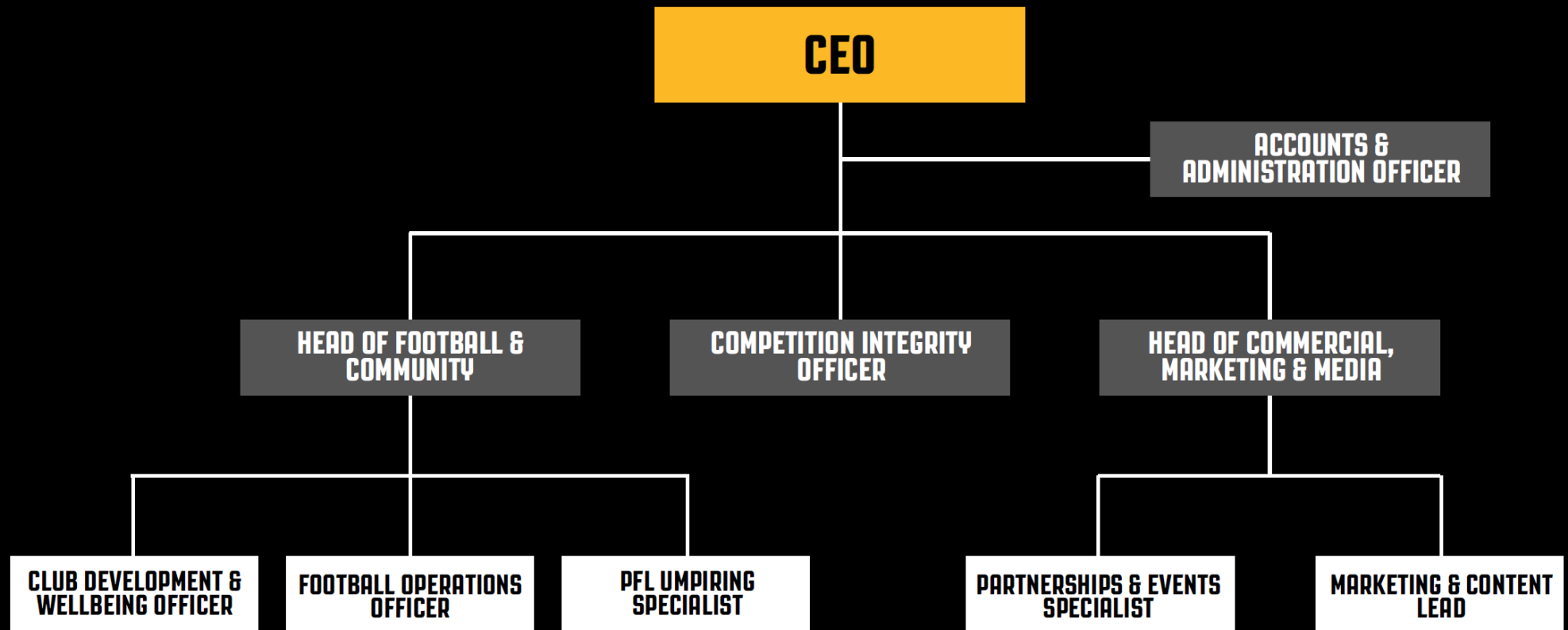
Jarryd Emery – Head of Commercial, Marketing and Media
