

2026 “Starkick All-Abilities” Design a Jumper Competition

We invite students enrolled in a recognized Education support program, school or centre to participate in the annual Starkick design a jumper competition. Your entry package is enclosed, with instructions and contact details.

Aim: *To have students demonstrate a sense of school pride/identity and get involved in football in a cross-curricular manner, this activity can also assist in engaging those students who may not necessarily participate in sports.*

Competition details:

- Entries close **5.00pm, Friday 3rd of July 2026**
- Students **MUST** be enrolled within a West Australian Education Support Program, centre or school to participate in this competition.
- Entry is open to students in both the public and private education systems.
- **Maximum 2 entries** per school.
- Entries are restricted to students enrolled between **Years 3 through to Year 8**
- Entries to include a short reflection on the students’ reasons for their design. *(Teachers may assist in writing this summary)* We recommend students are encouraged to pay attention to local landmarks, their school ethos, location as well as local population demographics when considering their design.
- Entries must be scanned and uploaded in PDF format for judging purposes.
*(We encourage all students to participate in the activity; however, schools must undertake their own selection process to **choose the 2 entries to be entered in the competition** in line with the competition rules)*
- **Please note:** Any designs that contain traditional Aboriginal artwork (sometimes referred to as “dot-paintings”) due to sensitive cultural reasons, can only be submitted if they were created by an Aboriginal student. Teachers are not permitted to submit any non-Aboriginal student designs that contain traditional Aboriginal artwork.

Judging Details:

- Entries will be judged by a panel from WA Football.
- The entry selected to be the best and most thoughtful design will WIN a Full set of Football jumpers for the school as well as a Jumper for the winning student replicating the submitted design.
- The Winning design will be announced in Term 3 in line with the Starkick Education Support Football Carnival.
- Jumpers will be presented to the school at a mutually agreed time and place.
