




#### WESTERN AUSTRALIAN AMATEUR FOOTBALL LEAGUE PRESIDENTS REPORT 1996

Season 1995 was the 75th Anniversary of the formation of the W.A.A.F.L. Since its humble beginnings in 1922 with five teams it has grown to 136 teams with nearly 7,000 registered players.

The Amateur League continues to play an important role in the development of young persons to either achieve higher honours (playing, umpiring, coaching or administration) in either the WAFL or AFL or just provide organized football for the average "bloke" in the street.

During the past season changes have taken place. With the stepping down of Don Baker from the Presidency this has led to the election of a new President and Vice President along with several new board members. Don has been a great ambassador and support of Amateur Football for over 30 seasons and the League is grateful for his extended efforts.

Club delegates met every six weeks, Club Secretaries and Treasurers undertook familiarisation seminars, hopefully, opening the way for more interaction with Board Members and Clubs. Board Members were each allocated three Clubs. Over the season delegates discussed and approved of a new grading system for 1997, along with a new fines and penalties format, in place, it should be interesting to say the least next season. Premiership medals and pennants were presented for the first time at all grades at the conclusion of Grand Finals.

The WAAFL continued to participate in the Metropolitan Football Leagues Council (with Sunday FL, Peel FL, SuperRules and Women's FL), the main purpose, the allocation of W.A.F.C. funding (via Ministry of Sport) and discussion of commission problems.

State and representative football had mixed success with the Colts team (coached by Bill Armstrong) performing creditable in several games. The Seniors found tough opposition in their two outings (vs Combined Country League and the SA Amateurs) under the direction of coach John Nykyforak. The Australian Amateur Football Council was wound up and the future of Amateur Football Carnivals at an end. Interstate games are too expensive to be justified and we look forward to playing representative football against mainly metropolitan based football leagues.

The Members of the Board are fully aware of clubs finding it difficult to meet their financial commitments, with that in mind, seminars with Club Treasurers, Secretaries and Fund Raisers are in place for early 1997.

The recruitment and retention of League Panel Umpires (field, boundary and goal) continues to be of concern, this has led to the growing importance of the compulsory Club Umpires system whom receive a greater level of instruction through the courses conducted by the W.A.A.F.L. Panel Umpires maintained a high level of performance expected of them.

Other important areas for the good running of Amateur football also played important roles, many behind the scene and without fuss and fan fare. These included weekly tribunals, reinstatement, sub-committees, umpires appointment board, weekly presentation on 6NR, state football sub committee, functions, sponsorship co-ordinator.

The Swan Brewery, Coca-Cola Bottlers, Perth, Ross Faulkner Footballs, Bakewell Foods, Smith + Nephew, Healthways, AudioCom are to be acknowledge with Clubs appreciative of their support of Amateur Sport.

Throughout the year the Office Staff, Executive Officer Neil Judge, Office Manager Avis Beasley and Diane Clausen continued to give efficient service, thanks to their combined efforts Clubs have been given good attention.

With the bringing forward of the AGM from February to November this has enabled the Board of Management to get many functions in place over the normally 'dormant' months, with particular attention to several areas addressed by appointed Projects Officer Milton Sanders.

My gratitude to all the people who served on the Board Of Management, Alan Clement (Vice President), George Livingstone (Treasurer), Bruce Wainwright (Secretary), David Thompson, Doug Frame, Milton Sanders, John Prior, Peter Gepp, Bob Stow, Tony Tarulli and Graeme Jacques with special mention to Mark Hodgson and Roger Steinepreis who have completed their elected terms and are not renominating.

The W.A.A.F.L and Clubs continue to exist on a broad base of tireless volunteers, without whose commitment we would not exist as successful as we continue to do. If you helped in any capacity my sincere THANKS!

#### UMPIRE ADVISER'S REPORT 1996

In 1996 the Amateur Umpires again enjoyed a successful season both on and off the field.

Showing initiative and commitment to the League, the umpires staged a most successful Pre-season Carnival, involving most A Grade sides, and the Beverley Football Club. Eventually won by Scarborough, all clubs and umpires gave the Carnival the thumbs up and hopefully the concept will continue in future years.

Financial sponsorship gained from Hyundai, Bill Milland, Easifleet and Healthways, provided the umpires association with the opportunity to again present awards and rewards for effort and commitment to umpiring on this panel.

Four umpires again travelled overseas this season. Two enjoyed the taste of Thailand in May and two enjoyed the sights of Hong Kong. All officiated in demonstration matches of our Australian game during their trips.

The ultimate award presented in 1996 was the Easifleet award of the use of a brand new vehicle for a period of twelve months. This was won by Grand Final Field Umpire John Scott and capped a great season for him.

During the summer months of 1995/96 several Umpire Courses were conducted to prepare first season umpires with a grounding of the fundamentals of umpiring. These Courses were a great success, the proof being that four participants of those courses, field umpired A Grade seniors in season 1996 and will umpire more senior football in the future.

A recruitment/development initiative this season saw a number of new young umpires come onto our panel. These young umpires did a magnificent job this season, as did their mentors in Reg Statham, Bruce Wheatland, Colin Merigan and Dennis Miller, who gave these umpires on field quidance.

In addition, thirteen umpires completed the National Accreditation Level 2 and the fruits of this initiative were seen in many of these young umpires umpiring finals in their first season.

Everything about the umpires and the umpires Panel was positive in 1996. The umpires continued to improve on individual performances and the commitment level was of a high standard. The standard of football in the Amateur League reflects the quality of the umpiring at present.

The main area of Amateur Umpiring requiring Urgent attention, is the structure of the Umpires Board. In season 1996 it would be fair to say there was no Umpires Board. The involvement of Management Committee members in umpiring suffers when those selected to that role do not have the time or commitment to umpiring. Two jobs were given to the Umpires Board this season.

- 1. To have an advertising board made to advise persons of the Amateurs move to Inglewood Oval. (A task I was advised would take 24 hours.) and
- 2. To research records to locate the names of past grand final umpires.

Both these tasks remain outstanding, simply meaning someone else will have to do them.

Rather than be seen as criticism, let it be a signal that umpiring needs genuine support.

Perhaps, it is time the umpiring structure turned to a Director of Umpiring and full responsibility for the umpires Panel was undertaken by him. This is all but the situation at present and has been for the past two seasons. Umpire selections should never be queried because only those showing commitment and displayed ability are selected. Times have changed and umpiring is its own entity. All is positive. There will always be knockers and this season has unveiled several. Overall the Panel is developing very well and performances are very high.

The nature of the Panel has changed in the past two seasons and the Management Committee must see that Umpiring is in a very healthy state. Support is required from the League to keep this momentum going and have the umpiring personnel see that they have that support.

Observing of umpires continues to be a concern, however, initiatives put in place this season again proved successful. Feedback was consistently fed to me and umpires throughout the season.

The move of the umpires to Inglewood Oval this year will prove to be the best move the umpires have made. The umpires base is now in a heavily populated northern suburb and recruitment will flourish in 1997 and beyond. Support from the League to promote this venue is required.

In conclusion, this season was another season of building the Panel. The Panel is receiving positive exposure throughout umpiring circles and continues to attract new personnel and sponsorship. The once aging Panel is starting to attract young enthusiastic people positive for umpiring.

The umpires know they are accountable for their performances. I will always support my umpires when they are carrying out my instructions to umpire a free flowing but disciplined style of football. Players who play outside the Laws and instructions, will suffer the consequences, but in the long term, Amateur Football will be the winner. I know I am accountable to the Management Committee. I take my role seriously and my commitment to my umpires cannot be questioned.

Persons selected to carry out a role in this League need to give 100% commitment or stand aside and hand their position to someone else who can. The Amateur League competition has a great deal to offer given it is managed correctly by enthusiastic and productive members.

1997 will see more youth attracted to the Panel. New sponsorship will again put the Panel in an attractive position to recruit and retain personnel. All these developments take a great deal of effort and time. The position of Umpires Adviser being advertised recently makes me wonder where the Amateur League wants their umpiring to be in the future. I recall my initial interview where it was stressed that the Panel needed change. I'm more than satisfied that my role in the past two seasons has improved the standard of umpiring and football played in this competition.

Our Guest Speaker was Mark Hager (Australian Hockey Captain) who spoke on his career, culminating in the lead up and disappointment at the Atlanta Olympics and were he sees hockey going in the future. In the Presidents absence, Alai Clement (Vice President) presented the Fairest and Best and other awards.

The evening although successful can be improved upon (especially the dress standard - NO JEANS, to mean no jeans) and management will be addressing this issue.

Secondly, the enthusiasm and professionalism of my support staff namely Martin Burgess (Manager/Selector), Geoff Horton (Selector/Runner) and Chris Stickland (Trainer) contributed significantly to the programme running efficiently. Additionally, the infrastructure provided by the WAAFL, through its representative Milton Sanders, assisted greatly in the co-ordination of the programme. I would sincerely like to thank all for their contribution.

However, it is the players who really ensure a successful State Colts programme. The State Colts is not an assembly of the most 'talented' players eligible. (There are various reasons why some players are unable to involve themselves.) It is, however, a squad that is comprised of the most 'committed and talented' players available for Amateur colts. It is the sacrifices, both on and off the field, that these players are prepared to make that ensures the WAAFL State Colts programme is given such a positive profile.

As one of these football players' many coaches, I hope that I have assisted in continuing their development. It is with anticipation that I wait to see many of them emerge as notable senior players both in Amateurs and at other levels. I wish each and everyone success of them in their football futures.
