# Where Did it Go

It is hard to believe that another year is drawing to a close, especially this one. It seems like only yesterday that the 2020 events were beginning, then ceased due to Covid-19, then started again after a 4-month lockdown.

Despite this, 2020 was once again a very successful year for the Swansmen, despite the net figure raised not as high as previous years due to the 4-month Covid-19 lockdown, over \$55,000 net was raised in just 3 months through:

- Thursday Members Night, Chase the Ace and Raffle Wheel net \$11,000 (at the end of October);
- Cash Bonanza Raffle \$12,000 (thanks to Peter Snow for coordinating);
- Auction \$32,000 (thanks to the Committee, Ross Leipold and the Club staff and all the donors);
- Home Game Winning Margins \$1,000 (thanks to George van der Meulen);
- Membership subs, Lounge Bar Sales, monthly dinner meetings and fines.

This was an outstanding achievement by all involved under the circumstances and they should be proud of their efforts.

These funds were returned to the Club through the annual sponsorship of the Count-Me-In Round table; a payment towards the memorabilia room; the Men's Leading Goal Kicking Award; the Women's Fairest & Best Awards and the end of season donation.

The monthly dinner meetings were successful after the lockdown, with approximately 30 in attendance each month. We heard from coaches, players and a diverse range of entertaining guest speakers including Adam Pickering, Ted Polglaze (Club Sport Scientist), John McGuire (Sporting and Cultural Ambassador) and representatives from the Bus Preservation Society of WA (based at Whiteman Park). A big thanks to Des Hardiman for organising the guest speaker list for 2020 and look forward to a wide range of speakers for 2021.

The Xmas Lunch was held at Kappys Italian Trattoria in Guildford on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> December. 35 attendees were treated to a four course Italian feast, with everyone going home a few kilos heavier. The Secret Santa present was back again with Jim Benson donning the Big Red hat with his trusty elf Steve Grech handing out the gifts to the Ladies.

The relationship with the Club has grown stronger in 2020, with their assistance in the Auction and Thursday Night Members Nights being of valuable importance to the fundraising efforts. Both parties are keen to forge a stronger relationship in 2021 for the betterment of the Club.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the 2020 Swansmen Committee for all their support over the last year, without whom, I would not have been able to have survived the year.

Finally, I would like to wish you and your families a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year and look forward to a bigger and better 2021, ON and OFF the field.
