- To ensure alignment with the Senior Program to best enhance each players ability to transition successfully between programs

KEY ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES & KPI's

PLANNING & IMPLEMENTING AN EFFECTIVE TRAINING PROGRAM

- Preparing, communicating and implementing a training program which is appropriate to WAFL Futures Level and caters to the development of future East Perth Senior Footballers
- In consultation with East Perth FC Staff, ensure that the program reflects an appropriate balance between skill acquisition, strategy, strength & conditioning and player's personal development
- To liaise with East Perth TM, FM & Senior Coach to ensure that the program reflects all East Perth Talent Development Strategies, Game Plans and Team Rules (ensures consistency across the club)
- To ensure that the program caters for individual differences, rehabilitating players and players with varying workloads outside of WAFL Futures (Regional, PSA, Schools Sports, WA State Academy etc.)
- To liaise with the East Perth TM to ensure that the program is resourced appropriately
- To effectively communicate all training plans with coaching staff, East Perth TM, FM and Senior Coach

MATCH-DAY OPERATIONS

- To ensure that all match-day strategies are in accordance with East Perth Philosophies and Objectives
- To ensure that all team strategies and rules are well prepared, communicated and implemented
- To ensure that all team strategy and terminology are in line with the East Perth Senior Program
- To communicate in an effective and educational manner with players and coaches on game-day to maximise player performance and development
- To ensure that appropriate support staff roles and structures are in place to coach effectively
- To ensure appropriate coaching box etiquette and communication with coaches and players
- To communicate and engage with all essential match-day personnel (property, umpires etc.)

INFORMATION, COMMUNICATION & PROGRAM MANAGEMENT

- To provide clear communication and instructions to all players, coaches and staff pre-training, at training, post-training, pre-match, during match and post-match
- To provide accurate and timely feedback (written, verbal & visual) to all players which address both long-term development and weekly performance (training and match-day)
- To ensure that player instructions, roles and responsibilities are clearly communicated and understood pre-match (during training weeks and before the game)
- To produce and provide all players with post-match reports (in consultation with Assistant Coaches) which include various ratings and feedback on their ability to perform their communicated role
- To communicate clearly and concisely with all players on matters of team selection and performance
- To act in an appropriate manner when addressing parents or stakeholders and refer difficult situations or conversations to the East Perth TM
- To ensure that all conversations with players or parents regarding team selection or player discipline are only initiated in the presence of the East Perth TM (or FM if required)
- To liaise with various WA State Academy, PSA, School, Junior Community, Regional and Amateur Coaches or Staff regarding player performance and development when transitioning between grades
- To ensure regular communication and interaction with the East Perth Senior Program on matters of Team Performance, Coaching, Strategy and Player Development



KEY ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES & KPI's cont.

SQUAD MANAGEMENT

- To ensure that the East Perth TM (& FM if required) oversee and manage Squad Selection
- To ensure that Match-Day Selection is overseen by East Perth TM (& FM if required) and follows the East Perth Selection Policy in line with East Perth Philosophies and Objectives
- To attend all Football Operations Meetings which relate to Futures Squad Management, Development and the Promotion or Graduation of players
- To make various considerations for players with Cultural or Geographical challenges which may be affecting their ability to access the program or their match-day/training performance
- To conduct Post Season meetings with all players reviewing and updating Individual Player Development Plans and off-season focusses
- To attend any meetings held between the East Perth Senior Program and Graduating or Transitioning Colts Players to ensure clear and consistent messaging

TALENT IDENTIFICATION & DEVELOPMENT

- To attend various WA State Academy, WAFL, PSA, School, Junior Community, Regional and Amateur Fixtures to track player development, performance and identify new talent
- To assist the East Perth TM in developing and maintaining various scouting networks
- To develop and maintain an Individual Development Plan for each player which focusses on Strengths, Improvement Areas and tracks development or regression in the player over time
- To present reports on player development and performance to the East Perth Football Department (TM, FM and Senior Coach) at regular intervals of the season

STAFF MANAGEMENT

- To assist in the recruitment of professional staff that will positively contribute to the program
- To clearly demonstrate preferred staffing and coaching structures and implement effectively
- To encourage and support the integration of staff into the East Perth Football Club
- To encourage and support coach and staff development and progression
- To demonstrate leadership towards all staff within the program
- To communicate effectively with all staff in the program
- To foster a positive and enjoyable environment which retains and develops staff and coaches

CLUB DEVELOPMENT

- Engage with Club Development Opportunities presented by the Football Department and the Board
- To assist the East Perth Football Club and District Staff to develop coaching in the East Perth Metro and Regional Zones (PD Opportunities, Coaching Presentations, Attending/Running Training Sessions)
- To attend all meetings and functions as requested by the East Perth Football Club
- To facilitate and support the integration of all staff and players between the Futures Program and the East Perth Football Club
